



The Weather



High yesterday was 89° The low this morning was 75°
Winds peaked out Thursday at about 31 mph in gusts.

Today: Mostly cloudy with a low around 89° and S-SE wind 15-20 mph with gusts to 25.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low around 72° and S-SE wind 15-20.

Saturday: Partly sunny with a high near 89° and S-SE wind 10-15 mph and gusty. Overnight it should be down to about 69° and still windy, out of the S-SE.

Sunday: Partly sunny and up to 89° and still with that S-SE wind that will carry on until morning.

Memorial Day morning should bring us more sunshine and a warm, slightly windy afternoon, topping out about 91° with the wind out of the south.

The new business has lots of Texas quaints, useful decorations and Lampasas memorabilia. Much of it goes back to the days of Mr. W.C. Gillen, a prominent man in Lampasas many years ago. Mr. Gillen and wife Kate settled here in 1930. C.W. and sons Choc and Van Dyke had a horse polo team and C.W. raised, trained and raced thoroughbred horses. He had a cotton gin and store downtown, and there was a dairy farm operation east of town. Much of his business property was located just southeast of Courtyard Square and along Sulphur Creek. There's little left now, save the "Gillen's Guernsey Milk" bottles around town, and now, a collection of memorabilia at Gillen's Mercantile.

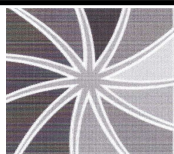
