**Today:** Mostly cloudy skies and a high temperature near 79°, and a 70% chance of showers and storms courtesy of the upper low moving through Central Texas. Winds will be SE at 5-15 mph.

**Tonight:** Look for mostly cloudy skies and a 30% chance of showers and storms, with a low temperature near 68°. Winds will continue SE near 5-15 mph.

**Tuesday:** There is a 50% chance of precipitation with showers and storms, with partly sunny skies. The high temperature will be near 82°, and the wind will be S-SE at 5-10 mph gusting to 20 mph.

**Tuesday Night:** Cloudy skies with a low temperature near 69°, and a 30% chance of showers and storms. Winds will continue S-SE at 5-15 mph.

**Wednesday:** A 20% chance of precipitation with partly sunny skies and a high near 85°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

## Meetings Monday

**The Lampasas County Commissioners Court** will meet Monday at 9am for a regular meeting. The Agenda included the consent agenda, accounts payable & payroll, and recognition of Dr. Georgia Hay, the Lampasas County Health Authority. The meeting will then go into Executive Session regarding the negotiation of legal responsibilities related to the completion of construction of the Lampasas County Jail & Sheriff's office and the default by Kreuger Construction Company. Following executive session, the agenda includes; final certificate of payment to finalize the new Law Enforcement Center, business with the River Hills Ranches Phase IIB, The county Hazard Mitigation Plan, Central County Services business, and an asbestos, lead, mold inspection/survey of the old jail.

**The Lampasas City Council** will meet beginning at 5:30pm on Monday for a special session to administer the oath of Office to newly elected mayor and members, reappointing the Municipal Court Judge and appointment of a mayor pro-tem. This will be followed by a workshop session with discussion regarding the Covid-19 Pandemic, the livestock/fowl ordinance, the City council Work Plan, and Hostess House Improvements. The regular session will include citizen comments, the consent agenda, board and department reports, routine matters, the City Manager's Operational report to include a report on the Court of Appeals, Rugged Sweep, and storm impacts. In new business, there will be discussion of an ordinance amending guarantee of performance, a voluntary annexation of Hillside Acres, for the

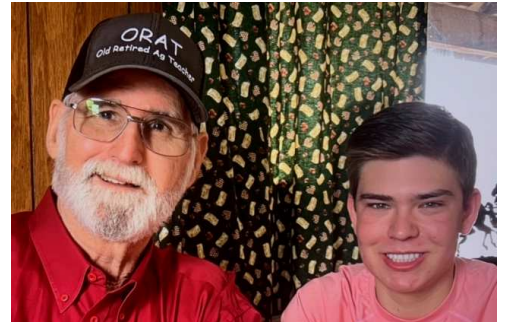
Lampasas Police Dept. to purchase a vista-com recording solution, and a proposed feasibility assessment to preserve New Hope Baptist Church in the amount of \$9800. Council will then go into Executive Session, relating to utilities, and then return to regular session for action on executive session
