## Runoff Election Day

Texas is holding its 2022 runoff elections today to finalize which Democratic and Republican primary candidates will be on the ballot in the November general election. Mail-in ballots will be counted if they are postmarked no later than 7pm today and are received by the county by 5pm tomorrow.

In our area, the most interesting race is the one between Dee Ann Crawford and Dianne Miller for County Clerk. There is also a runoff for the District 24 Senate seat, the runoff is between Raul Reyes and Pete Flores.

The statewide runoffs for democrats are as follows: Attorney General, Rochelle Garza vs. Joe Jaworski; Lt. Governor, Michelle Beckley vs. Mike Collier; Land Commissioner, Jay Kleberg vs. Sandragrace Martinez; State Comptroller Janet Dudding

vs. Angel Luis Vega.

The statewide runoffs for Republicans are as follows; Attorney General, George P. Bush vs. Ken Paxton; Land Commissioner, Dawn Buckingham vs. Tim Westley and Railroad Commissioner, Wayne Christian vs. Sarah Stogner.

Residents can vote today in Lampasas at the election office at 407 S. Pecan St., Suite 102. The other voting locations are at the Kempner Fire Station at 315 S. Pecan, in Kempner and at the Lometa City Hall at 100 E. San Saba St. in Lometa.

## District Court Notes

**Lampasas County Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on May 20th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 40 cases were brought to the court with 24 cases involving men, and 16 cases involving women.

There were 14 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1, with one being in a drug free zone. There were 9 cases for less than a gram, and 4 cases for 1-4 grams. There was 1 case for manufacture and delivery/possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams, and there were 3 DWI cases.

There were four burglary cases and two cases each for forgery and engaging in organized activity. There was one case each for bail jumping/failure to appear, aggravated perjury, fraud, unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and one case for a prohibited substance in a correctional facility.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 4 cases of assault of a family member. There was one case each for indecency with a child/sexual contact, intoxication assault, injury to a child/disabled person, sexual assault and failure to comply with registering as a sex offender.

Of the 44 cases, 9 were resolved with Cody Bell pleading nolo contendere to the charge of burglary of a habitation/intend other felony and was sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs and a fine. Kimberly Uhler saw her aggravated perjury charge dismissed. Dustin Meier plead guilty and was sentenced to 12 months state jail with credit for days served plus court costs on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. On the charge of sexual assault, Danny Sanchez plead guilty and was sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs. Jose Charles-Bruzon was sentenced to 3 years at TDCJ with credit for days served for pleading guilty on the charge of fraud/use/possession of indentifying information. Krystal Strassberg, on the charge of DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> or more, plead guilty and was sentenced to 10 years TDCJ with all 10 years probated with the stipulation she attends an SAFFP program. Christopher Faubion, on the charge of possession of a controlled substance 1-4 grams, plead guilty and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ. On the charge of burglary of a building, Mr. Faubion was sentenced to 18 months in state jail. He will receive credit for days served. Douglas Wheat plead guilty to DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> or more and was sentenced to 10 years TDCJ with all 10 years probated. He must serve 10 days in the county jail and his drivers license will be suspended for 24 months. All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials.
