## In Lampasas Radio Studios

**Lampasas City Manger Finely de Graffenried** visited with Ronnie Witcher this morning on Lampasas Radio.

The City Manager shared that there was a lightning strike on a house on W. North in the storms last night.

They spoke about the swearing-in of the new council members, Zachary Morris (Place 1), Eric Hernandez (Place 2), and Charlie Pratus (Place 6). The new Mayor, Herb Pearce, was also sworn in.

They discussed the remodeling and possible uses for the Historic Colored School and the New Hope Baptist Church.

Mr. de Graffenried spoke of the public hearing to rezone approximately 79 acres from agriculture to residential off Mill St. and 4<sup>th</sup> St. He stressed that this was only the re-zoning and that now the actual subdivision process will begin. This will include traffic and drainage studies and civil designs and will have to be completed before ground is broken. The subdivision will include 200+ homes

and about 2.1 acres of commercial property. He also spoke of the growth this area is experiencing.

Mr. Witcher asked about the Pitt Creek Subdivision located a few miles out of town, and Mr. de Graffenried stated that the WCID is only concerned about the impact to the dam structures in the flood control area and the impacts of impervious cover of the area.

## District Court Notes



**Lampasas County Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on May 19th.

Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 26 cases were brought to the court with 19 cases involving men and 7 cases involving women.

There were 14 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 5 cases for possession less than a gram with two of those being in a drug free zone, 3 cases for possession of 1-4 grams, and 1 case for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There was one case of manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone. There were 2 DWI cases. *(cont'd on back)*

## The Blotter



**Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Tuesday** shows a noise complaint in the 600 block of S. The afternoon shows a harassment in the 900 block of E. 4<sup>th</sup> St. at 12:07pm, a disturbance in the 1000 block of E. 4<sup>th</sup> St. at 6:48pm, and a suspicious vehicle reported in the 800 block of N. Ridge St. at 9:19pm.

**The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter** for Tuesday shows Lometa with a medical call. In Kempner there was an alarm call, medical calls, and animal issues. Out in the county there was an abandoned vehicle, a reported fraud, a burglary, medical calls, an alarm call, and a request for extra patrol. Deputies went into Cove on a repossession, animal issues and a medical call.

**The Jail Log** shows the arrest of 37 year old Trisha Durham of Hamilton on 2 out-of-county charges.

(cont'd from front) There were 3 cases for bail jumping, 2 cases each for evading arrest and fraud, and one case each for engaging in organized criminal activity and burglary.

In crimes involving personal harm, there was 1 case each for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and assault of a public servant. There was 1 case of sexual assault and 1 case for failing to register as a sex offender.

Of the 26 cases 3 were resolved with Christopher Moreno pleading guilty to failing to comply as a sex offender and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ probated for 5 years, plus court costs and a fine. Patrick Lee saw his probation adjudicated on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams, was found guilty and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ. On the charge of evading arrest/detention, Joshua Jackson of Kempner was sentenced to 4 years in TDCJ with credit for days served.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.

## Kempner WSC Boil Water Notice

Due to the line break on Pedernales Ln, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required the Kempner Water Supply Corporation, 1410028, public water system to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc). Children, seniors, and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all customers should follow these directions.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and ice making should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes. The water should be brought to a vigorous rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, individuals may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the public water system officials will notify customers that the water is safe for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

This boil notice is specifically for those who experienced loss of water from the leak on Pedernales Ln. Specifically, Hickory, Peach St., CR 4620, Pecan St., Pedernales Ln., CR 4616, and Pecos Ln.
