## The Weather



**The High yesterday 93° The Low this morning 61°.**

**Today:** Sunny skies with a high temperature near 95°. Wind will be light from the S-SW near 5 mph

**Tonight:** Look for clear skies with a low near 73°. Winds will be from the E-SE at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

**Saturday:** The sky will be sunny, and the high temperature will be near 98°. Wind will be S near 5-10 mph increasing to 15-20 in the afternoon, gusting to 25 mph.

**Saturday Night:** Look for mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 70°. The wind will be S near 15-20 mph and could gust as high as 25 mph.

**Sunday:** Sunny skies and a high temperature near 96°. Winds will be from the S at 10-20 mph with gusts of 25 mph.

**Overnight Sunday:** Mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 71°. Wind will be from the S-SE at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

## Texas Wildfire Danger

This Memorial Day, Texas A&M Forest Service encourages Texans to protect our great state by being mindful of activities that may start a wildfire. The start of summer is marked by vacations, outdoor activities like camping and grilling and celebrating holidays with family and friends – all of which could lead to sparking a wildfire.

Between 2017 and 2021, Texas A&M Forest Service responded to 3,682 wildfires burning 1.4 million acres. Almost half of these wildfires occurred during the summer months, where the majority were caused by humans and their activities.

In Texas, 9 out of 10 wildfires are human-caused and completely preventable. The most common causes of wildfire ignitions during the summer months are debris burning and equipment use, which includes parking in dry grass and dragging trailer chains.

“Texas A&M Forest Service encourages all residents to stay safe during the holiday weekend,” said Karen Stafford, Texas A&M Forest Service Wildfire Prevention Program Coordinator. “Every Texan has a role to play in protecting our state from wildfires and preventing any new ignitions. Remember to do your part, and don’t let a wildfire start.”

While some portions of the state have received rainfall recently, some regions have not received any significant precipitation. The hot, dry summer months will continue to intensify drought conditions and support wildfire ignitions.

“The high summer temperatures across the state and an abundance of grass, brush and other dry vegetation can quickly turn an unintended spark into a wildfire,” says Stafford. “Be mindful of conditions and cautious of your outdoor activities that may cause a spark.”

## Tax Free Weekend

The Comptroller encourages all taxpayers to support Texas businesses while saving money on tax-free purchases of certain ENERGY STAR® energy-efficient products during the annual Texas ENERGY STAR Sales Tax Holiday. There is no limit on the number of qualifying items you can buy, and you do not need to give the seller an exemption certificate to buy items tax free.

The 2022 tax-free ENERGY STAR Sales Tax Holiday begins Saturday, May 28, and goes through midnight on Monday, May 30 (Memorial Day).

You can buy, rent or lease only the following ENERGY STAR®-labeled items tax free: air conditioners (with a sales price of \$6,000 or less), refrigerators (with a sales price of \$2,000 or less), ceiling fans, incandescent and fluorescent light bulbs, clothes washers, dishwashers, and dehumidifiers.

Residential lawn and garden customers can buy the following products without tax:

Drip Irrigation: helps save water by slowly placing water closer to the root zone, where plants can take advantage, reducing evaporation and excess runoff, lowering your summer water bill!

The Hanna Springs pool will open tomorrow, May 28th from 12pm-7pm and May 29th and 30th from 12pm-5pm. The pool will be closed on May 31st.
