## The Weather

## Trooper Talk:

### Human Trafficking

Sgt. Bryan Washko of the Texas DPS was in the Lampasas Radio studios this morning. The subject was human trafficking. In Texas, 234,000 people are the subject of human trafficking in Texas at any given time. 79,000 of those are minors.



This is really more prevalent than most people think.

Sgt. Washko put it like this: Human trafficking is like any commodity. So look on the busy highways, they can move more on the larger highways than on the back roads.

He advised to look for anything unusual. If there are adults that are well dressed and clean, and children that are not, that is a sign something may be wrong. If a child looks afraid, or scared of the person they are with that may be a sign.

He asks that the public keeps an eye out at large truck stops along the highways with a lot of foot traffic where kids may not be as noticed. If you are suspicious, call someone.

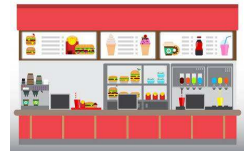

## Water Parks/Food Courts

### Next to Open

Beginning Friday, May 29th, water parks can open but must limit their occupancy to 25% of normal operating limits. Components of these water parks that have video arcades must remain closed. Starting Sunday, May 31st, recreational sports programs for adults can resume, but games and similar competitions may not begin until June 15th. Driver education programs can resume operations immediately. Food-court dining areas within shopping malls can also immediately resume operations, but malls are encouraged to designate one or more individuals who are responsible for ensuring health and safety practices are followed, including: limiting tables to six individuals; maintaining a six-foot distance between individuals sitting at different tables; cleaning and disinfecting tables between uses; and ensuring no condiments or other items are left on tables between customer uses.



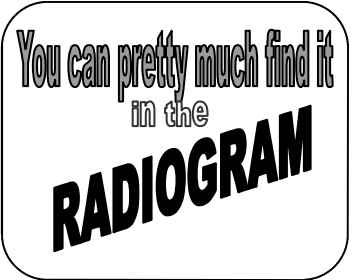

## Mail-In Voting Ruling

According to a story in the Texas Tribune "The Texas Supreme Court ruled Wednesday that a lack of immunity to the new coronavirus does not qualify a voter to apply for a mail-in ballot.

In the latest twist in the legal fight over voting by mail during the coronavirus pandemic, [the court agreed](#) with Texas Attorney General [Ken Paxton](#) that the risk of contracting the virus alone does not meet the state's qualifications for voting by mail.

"We agree with the State that a voter's lack of immunity to COVID-19, without more, is not a 'disability' as defined by the Election Code," the court wrote.

Texas voters can qualify for mail-in ballots only if they are 65 years or older, have a disability or illness, will be out of the county during the election period, or are confined in jail. The Texas election code defines disability as a "sickness or physical condition" that prevents a voter from appearing in person without the risk of "injuring the voter's health."

When voters cite disability to request an absentee ballot, they're not required to say what the disability is. The voters simply check a box on the application form, and if their application is properly filled out, local officials are supposed to send them a ballot. The state ultimately conceded that officials can't reject those voters.

A separate case is pending in federal court, where a three-judge panel of the U.S. 5th Circuit Court of Appeals temporarily blocked an expansion of voting by mail ordered by a lower court. The appellate panel granted what's known as an administrative stay, which only stops the lower court ruling from taking effect while the court considers whether it will issue an injunction nullifying it during the entire appeals process.

The issue is being fought on multiple fronts but is likely headed to the U.S. Supreme Court as Texas Republican officials continue to resist expanding voting by mail during the pandemic."
