Today: Mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 84° and a 60% chance of showers and storms. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph. There will be a threat for strong to severe storms today southeast of I-20 and west of I-35. Large hail, damaging winds and flooding will be a threat. Additional storms will be possible overnight.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy skies and a low near 66° with a 70% chance of showers. Winds will continue S-SE at 5-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Saturday: Partly sunny skies with a high temperature near 79°, and a 50% chance of showers and storms. S-SE winds will become E in the afternoon at 5-10 mph.

Saturday Night: Mostly cloudy skies and a low temperature near 65°. Winds will be E-SE near 10 mph.

Farewell From Dr. Hay

Lampasas County Health Authority

The past 15 months have felt like much longer to myself as well as countless others. I am happy to see the steady decline in COVID-19 cases, hospitalizations, and fatalities as the usage of the vaccines has increased. Almost 30% of the county is vaccinated fully now and I've seen first hand how effective it can be. As I resign from being the Local Health Authority for the county, I wanted to say a few parting words. I have so many people to thank who helped whenever I called. There are so many that donated their time, talents, and hearts to help those in our community. Countless volunteers for vaccination clinics and my contact tracing team gave a tremendous effort for the citizens of Lampasas County. I also wanted to humbly offer my condolences for those that lost loved ones from our county as well as those who perished across the country. I pray that God gives you comfort during this time. Our COVID numbers are improving, but these folks are the solemn reminder of the worst of this pandemic. I do believe the vaccines are a safe and effective way to prevent fatalities and hospitalizations from this disease. I had a patient who lost a family member to COVID share a quick story with me that I'd like to share with you. It started with flooding in an area and a man climbing higher and higher in his house. He was a man with a strong faith and said "God will save me". He climbed higher as the water rose and a rescue crew on a (cont'd on back)

Legislature Issues

The Verbal Sparring between Texas leaders began yesterday, as Lt. Gov. Dan Patrick specifically wants a June special session — prior to the special session that Abbott is widely expected to call this fall to address redistricting and COVID-19 relief funds. Abbott indicated Wednesday he was not immediately on board with Patrick's demand, and commented during an unrelated news conference in Fort Worth.

"That's pretty goofy because everybody knows there's only one person with the authority to call a special session, and that's the governor," Abbott said of Patrick's push for a special session. During special sessions, lawmakers are only allowed to consider legislation on subjects selected by the governor. Abbott said that if he initiates a special session, he would not load up the agenda with multiple items for lawmakers to address at once but would "go one item at a time. So if anyone tries to hold hostage this legislative session to force a special session," Abbott said, "that person will be putting their members, in the Senate or the House, potentially into a special session for another two years because I'm gonna make sure that we get things passed, not just open up some debating society."
