**Saturday:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 91° and a low around 72°. SSW wind will come in at 5 to 10mph, with 20mph gusts.

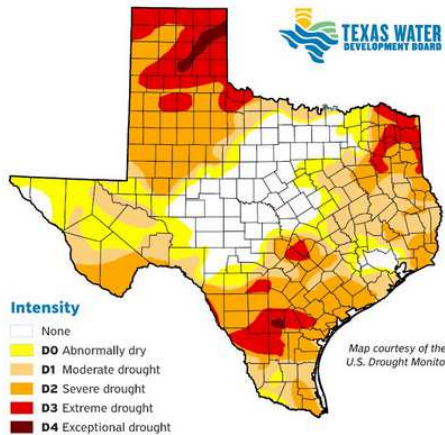
**Sunday:** Mostly sunny, with a high near 92° and a low around 74°. Southern wind will move in at 5 to 10mph.

## Water News - No Change in Drought Area

The Texas Water Development Board posted the most recent map for conditions as of May 19th. The map shows no change and a break in the six consecutive weeks of drought contraction. TWDB stated that we should see more of a drought contraction due to recent rainfall.

Conditions are 65% now and were 65% a week ago. Cumulative precipitation for San Antonio has been below the 1991-2020 annual average of 32.4in every year since 2022, according to TWDB. With 11.53 inches, 2022 was the driest of these years. So far, the wettest year has been 2025 with 27.04in. As of May 17th, this year has been slightly wetter than last year.

Lake Stillhouse is 100% full as of May 27th and Lampasas County still remains in no drought.



## Shooting Incident Update

### Copperas Cove Police Report

On Wednesday, May 27th, 2026, at approximately 8:09 a.m., the Copperas Cove Police Department responded to a report of shots fired in the 700 block of South 13th Street. Upon arrival, officers located an **adult male suffering from a gunshot wound.**

The suspect, **Davarious Jashawn Lee**, was later located in the area of the shooting and arrested without further incident. Lee was charged with Aggravated Assault Causing Serious Bodily Injury – Family Violence and arraigned by Coryell County Justice of the Peace Guinn on Thursday, May 28th, 2026. His bond was set at \$600,000.

This investigation remains active. The initial charge is subject to enhancement or additional charges pending further review of evidence by the Coryell County District Attorney's Office.

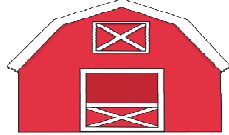

### Fatal Hill County Crash Sgt. Bryan Washko

**Texas DPS Troopers responded to a fatal crash** on Farm to Market Road 933 at Farm to Market Road 1304, south of Aquilla in Hill County. Preliminary investigation indicates an Acura passenger car was **traveling westbound on FM 1304 and approached a stop intersection**. A Ford pickup truck towing a gooseneck trailer was traveling northbound on FM 933. The Acura failed to yield the right of way at the stop intersection to the Ford and collided with the Ford.



**The driver of the Acura was identified** as 36-year-old Young Yong Kim of Copperas Cove. Kim was pronounced deceased at the scene by Hill County Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 Judge Doyle Jetton. The 72-year-old driver of the Ford was transported by Care Flite EMS to Baylor Scott & White Hillcrest **with non-life-threatening injuries**.

## Outstanding Burnet Municipal Court Warrant?

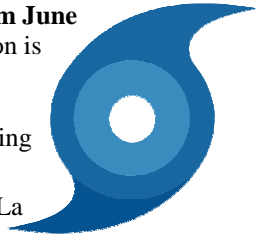

## Hurricane Season Starts Monday

**The Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1st to November 30th**, meaning the season is kicking off on Monday. Forecasters are predicting a "somewhat below-normal" to below-normal season due to the transitioning El Nino pattern.



According to colostste.edu, current weak La Nina conditions are likely to transition to El Nino in the next few months. **There is the potential for a moderate/strong El Nino for the peak of the hurricane season**. They anticipate the El Nino being the dominant factor for the upcoming hurricane season.

**NOAA predicts 8 to 14 named storms**, 3 to 6 hurricanes, and 1 to 3 major hurricanes. **Colorado State University forecasts 13 named storms**, 6 hurricanes, and 2 major hurricanes.

**The 2026 Atlantic names are:** Arthur, Bertha, Cristobal, Dolly, Edouard, Fay, Gonzalo, Hanna, Isaias, Josephine, Kyle, Leah, Marco, Nana, Omar, Paulette, Rene, Sally, Teddy, Vicky, and Wilfred.

**The 2025 hurricane season** was an above-normal season and had 13 named storms, 5 hurricanes, and 4 major hurricanes. Erin, Humberto, and Melissa reached Category 5 intensity.
