A new way of doing things..."

Dr. Georgia Hay, Lampasas County Health Authority was in Lampasas Radio Studios this morning for an update on the coronavirus situation.

Burnet County recorded its first death from COVID-19. On May 26<sup>th</sup>, a 57 year old resident of the Bertram Nursing Home passed away. Burnet County Judge James Oakley stated "The woman had significant pre-existing conditions, deteriorated rapidly, and tested posthumously as positive for the COVID-19 virus," according to the statement.

Health officials conducted contact tracing, which identified a staff member who had "very recently" tested positive for COVID-19 and had self-quarantined.

According to Oakley's release, officials tested the entire facility May 27 and all results came back negative May 28.

Dr. Hay stated in her interview this morning that Burnet County has new cases, but they are not on the state website at this time. Hamilton County also reported a death on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

At this time, she assures us that Lampasas County has no active cases. The total cases for Lampasas county is 9.

The drug trials, she said did not work out so well and the promising drugs are not so promising anymore. So the new way to do things may just be how it will be. Hand washing, social distancing, small groups and staying home if you feel sick.

She talked about the pool opening this weekend. The swimming doesn't concern her, but the common areas and surfaces will have to be sanitized regularly, as well as restrooms. She advised staying in small groups, have your blanket or area, and keep to that area.

**The Hancock Springs Pool** will be opening tomorrow. It will be held to 50% capacity and all persons must be Lampasas County residents. They will be checking ID's. Also, children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult, and parents need to sign paperwork for the kids ages 12-18.

**The St. Mary's Food Pantry** will be open this Saturday from 1-2:30pm for a drive-thru no contact food distribution. Please stay in your vehicle and someone will direct you.

**The Farmers Market on the Square** will begin Saturday from 8am-12pm.

**The Lampasas Public Library** will be open beginning Monday June 1<sup>st</sup>. The hours for now are Monday-Thursday 10-6 and Friday from 10-5. The guidelines are as follows:

\*PLEASE DO NOT COME IN IF YOU ARE ILL

\*We will allow up to 15 people in the library at once

\*No one under 12 years of age allowed without an adult

\*You are asked to use hand sanitizer upon entry

\*You are encouraged to wear a mask (some will be available if you do not have one)

\*You will be asked to sign in upon entry for tracing purposes

\*We are offering "Grab and Go" service – you can come in, select materials or pick up reserves, and leave in a timely manner.

\*There will be no computers, no seating, no programs, and no meeting room use until further notice.

\*We will still offer curbside (front porch) service to those who do not wish to come inside

**The Lampasas Mission** will be open beginning June 1<sup>st</sup> for drive-thru food pantry from 6-8pm.

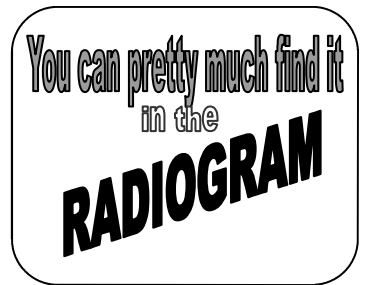

## New NBA Playoff Plans

According to ESPN's senior writer Zach Lowe, the NBA will be back soon with the following changes. The NBA's cleanest method of resuming its season is to bring the 16 current playoff teams to its designated "campus," seed them as they are now -- eight East, eight West -- and play the NBA's normal postseason.

Sticking to 16 limits the number of bodies, this cuts the chance of COVID-19 spreading. Forgoing the remainder of the regular season addresses that some players on current lottery teams may with good reason have little interest in a half-dozen meaningless games after three-plus months away. This however will need to be tinkered with due to the fact that the teams outside the 16 need to have something to play for like more bids to the next draft lottery. The complaint you hear in league circles about such concepts -- play-in tournaments, World Cup-style pool play -- is that they are gimmicky, and too far from what fans and the keepers of the game consider legitimate proceedings. This season's champion, should the season get that far, will already face the dreaded asterisk.
