## Lampasas ISD School Board Meets -- Central Appraisal District to Join the Discussion



The Lampasas Independent School Board will have a meeting TONIGHT at 6pm in the Administration Building.  
They will have a reorganization of the board -- Election of President, Election of Vice President, and Election of Secretary. They will also discuss a budget amendment. There will be notice of resignation of professional personnel. **An application for waivers is on the agenda including:** staff development minutes, foreign exchange students, and modified schedule state assessment testing days. There will be an application for a low attendance waiver. They will also discuss district contribution to health insurance and **breakfast and lunch prices for 2026-27.**  
The Lampasas Central Appraisal District will hold a **presentation.** That presentation will consist, in large part, of work the LCAD has been doing to solve problems of properties that weren't necessarily mapped correctly or for other reasons, not taxed properly. A **general gist of all this** is that the LCAD has been trying to get a bigger budget for their office. They point to needs for more personnel and new technology. This presentation before the school board will be followed by similar presentations to the other taxing entities. In the end, its all about money. Who pays, how much, and who gets it.  
**Consideration of an over-the-counter offer** to purchase tax-foreclosed property will be discussed. **More in discussion is:** planning for federal grant applications, public comment on federal grant programs, and the 2026 School Facility Bond.

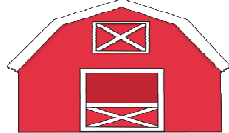

## Corpus Christi Reconsiders Building a Desalination Plant

The Corpus Christi City Council will meet tomorrow to decide if the city should revive a controversial and ambitious endeavor to build a desalination plant that would convert salty seawater into drinkable water. The project was already rejected by the council nine months ago over environmental concerns, **the expensive price tag on its construction** and the large amounts of energy it would take to run.

**The city is strapped for water** after a stubborn drought and rising demand. The community is divided on whether the plant is worth the cost to taxpayers and the toll on the local ecosystem.

**The facility is expected to cost around \$978.8 million**, which the water department says is a "guaranteed maximum price" – and about 25% cheaper than previous estimates.

Corpus Christi City Manager Peter Zaroni often calls the desalination plant idea, the Inner Harbor Desalination Project, a "drought-proof" solution that could produce up to 30 million gallons of drinking water a day. **The city's water department, mayor and some City Council members** view the proposed plant as the key to a dependable long-term water supply.

**Mayor Paulette Guajardo**, who is a strong supporter of the project, says Corpus Christi needs to plan for the long-run.

Isabel Araiza, co-founder of the citizens group **For the Greater Good**, isn't convinced.

"**It just makes sense in a practically closed-based system**," she said, "you don't dump 54 million gallons of brine and sludge into the bay every single day and not expect that to destroy the bay."

Instead, Araiza is asking city leaders to focus on forcing the coastal region's heaviest water users – oil refineries and petrochemical plants – to conserve water. She says the proposed project is "not a sustainable solution economically or environmentally, it's an industrial want," and that "the right moral and ethical choice" is to reject it again.



**Other community members** view the desalination plant as the city's last lifeline as water restrictions for all city customers could begin early 2027.

**Tuesday's meeting will cover** how the 25% water cuts would be put into effect, along with the desalination plant plans from two private companies. If approved tomorrow, the earliest a desalination facility would be up and delivering water is late 2029, which is too late to help the city dodge its immediate emergency needs.
