The Weather

The 87th Legislature

The 87th Legislature ended late Sunday night, when, according to the Texas Tribune, enough Democrats left the House to break a quorum and block passage of Senate Bill 7, the elections bill before the



midnight deadline.

Governor Abbott responded by stating that he would veto the section of the state budget that funds the legislature, tweeting "no pay for those who abandon their responsibilities".

The Bills that were sent to Abbott include Constitutional Carry, winter storm response, critical race theory, banning abortion if Roe vs. Wade is overturned, and the Governor has already signed the fetal heartbeat bill.

On his emergency list were election integrity and bail reform, and neither of these bills along with other priority bills were sent for the Governor's signature.

A special session is expected to be called and the Governor offered the following "I expect legislators to have worked out their differences prior to arriving back at the Capitol so that they can hit the ground running to pass legislation related to these emergency items and other priority legislation."
