Lampasas ISD School Board to Meet

The Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees will hold a regularly scheduled meeting today at 6pm at the Middle School Library located at 902 S. Broad St.

The agenda includes the Oath of Office for new and returning board members, reorganization of the Board including Election of President, Election of Vice President, and Election of Secretary. The agenda also includes the consent agenda covering budget amendments, resignation and selection of professional personnel, application for waivers (foreign exchange students, staff development minutes and modified schedule for state assessment

testing days and the summer school program for bilingual students in kindergarten and $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ grade). Also on the agenda are the following: list of bills, policy regarding leaves and absences-sick leave pool, breakfast and lunch prices, planning for Federal Grant Applications, public comment on Federal Grant Programs, administrative reports (end of year enrollment, school health advisory committee, and business/support services) and possible consultation with attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

Big Bold Plans for Big Divide

It looks like Tx DOT is going to change the look of 2-3 mile stretch of US 190E (or is it already I-14). The plans include the highway from the area of Big Divide up to FM 2657. The proposal is to convert the roadway on US 190 from a four-lane divided highway to a freeway section with frontage roads and overpasses ending at the Coryell County line in Lampasas County. The roadway will be divided with a 24' median and concrete barriers, constructing an overpass at Big Divide Road, and another at Great Hills Dr. This will change the entrance into Taylor Creek Elementary.

TxDOT states that the purpose of the project is to improve safety by constructing overpasses at high-traffic intersections and providing safer access by constructing one-way frontage roads, and improve mobility by adding service roads. This project spans approximately 2.3 miles and approximately 40 acres will be required for right of way.

TxDOT will be conducting a virtual open house with an in-person option. The online version will be available by noon on June 15th and the in-person meeting will be at Taylor Creek Elementary School from 5:30-7pm on June 15th. At the in-person meeting, a presentation will be given at 6pm and questions will be answered by staff during the open house meeting.
