

The Weather



There was no rain recorded at the airport yesterday.

Today: Mostly sunny with a high near 88° and a slight chance of showers this afternoon. Wind will become E-SE near 5 mph.

The Blotter

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter shows Lometa with medical calls, civil matters, animal issues, and a stolen vehicle. In Kempner there were medical calls, a reported trespassing and a warrant was served. Out in the county there were livestock/animal issues, an accident, civil matters, and medical calls. Deputies went into Cove on a requested welfare check, animal issues and a medical call.

(*cont'd from front*) **House Bill 28 enhances** the criminal penalty for some aggravated assaults from a second-degree felony to a first-degree felony.

House Bill 1442 provides law enforcement and prosecutors additional tools to go after organized street racing and street takeovers in Texas.

House Bill 2899 allows immediate removal of vehicles used in street racing or a reckless driving exhibition from the road.

Senate Bill 22 establishes the Rural Sheriff's Office Salary Assistance Grant Program and the Rural Prosecutor's Office Salary Assistance Grant Program for counties with a population of 300,000 or less.

Senate Bill 840 deters and punishes violence against healthcare workers in the workplace by enhancing the penalty for assault from a Class A misdemeanor to a third degree felony if the victim is a hospital employee on hospital property.

Senate Bill 1004 serves as a deterrent and increases accountability for parolees who have ankle monitors as part of their conditions of release by making it a state jail felony for anyone to tamper with or remove a required electronic monitoring device.

Senate Bill 224 increases the safety of Texans by enhancing penalties for the crime of catalytic converter theft.
