The forecasters say the cool front will arrive in the night, with the cooler drier air sticking around tomorrow for a high temperature about 10 degrees cooler. Temperatures will climb over the end of the week to the upper 90's.

Today: Sunny skies and a high temperature near 97°. Winds will be S-SW at 10-15 mph shifting W-NW this afternoon, gusting to 25 mph.

Tonight: Clear and a low near 61°. N wind at 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny with a high near 92° and a N winds at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday Night: Clear with a low near 63. Winds will become calm.

Thursday: Sunny with a high near 94° and light easterly breezes.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies and about 64° with winds becoming calm.

County Commissioner's Notes

The Lampasas County Commissioners held a regular meeting yesterday at 9am in the Lampasas County Courthouse in the Commissioner's Courtroom. There was discussion about streaming the meetings on a regular basis, and will look into the matter. The Spring Ho Proclamation/Resolution was approved by The Court and Spring Ho will be taking place from July 6th-12th. The majority of events will be taking place. Go to springho.com for information.

The preliminary plat for Race Riverbend Subdivision was approved. Lampasas Radio attempted to find out the location where this subdivision was being planned, but we were unable to obtain the information at this time. A replat was approved for Allen Estates.

A request from the Lometa Volunteer Fire Dept. was approved for the use of county resources. Lometa is in the process of building a 2nd Fire Station on the other side of the tracks. The issue comes when a train needs to switch tracks, blocking the roadway temporarily, preventing the fire equipment from crossing the tracks.

Lampasas Radio reached out to Lometa today, and we were told the property has been purchased and the building and concrete work have been donated. We understand the county monies would be used for equipment.

Approval was also given to dispose of, transfer, or sell surplus property which includes a 2001 Dodge Pickup, old lawnmowers, and various off ice equipment that no longer works.

A Resolution of Acceptance was accepted for the 2020 Coronavirus Relief Fund Grant, the 2020 CARES Help America Vote Grant, and the 2018 and 2020 Election Security Grant.

Lampasas County is eligible for nearly \$600,000 from the 2020 CARES Grant. Right now Lampasas County is eligible for 20% of that which is \$118,000. The funds will be used for reimbursement for non-budgeted expenditures directly related to public health issues as a result of COVID-19. Items like PPE safety equipment;

personal protection mask, temporary sneeze guards, system equipment for the live broadcast during the pandemic. The proposed takeover agreement with Traveler's Insurance was approved.

There was also an order prohibiting certain fireworks in unincorporated areas of Lampasas County. The Radiogram will publish a copy of this order this week.

District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on June 5th. Presiding over the Court was 27th district Judge John Gauntt.

Altogether 45 cases were brought to the court, 33 of them involved men and 12 involved women. Of the 45 cases, 7 defendants failed to appear and had warrants issued; for the charge of abandoning/endangering/neglecting a child, Dakota Price failed to appear, and Brittany Fox failed to appear on the same charge, different case. On the charge of possession PG1, 4-200 grams, Douglas Morrison of Fort Worth failed to appear. On the charge of possession PG1 less than a gram, Kentae Jackson was a no show. Jesse Salazar of Lampasas failed to appear on his possession PG1 less than a gram charge, as well as the charge of prohibited substance in a correctional facility. Gregory Lee Loper of Kempner failed to appear on the charge of bail jumping and failure to appear, as well as a possession PG1 less than a gram charge. Ryan Nelson Bass was FTA on the charge of assault of a family/household member, impeding breathing.

There were 16 cases involving possession of a controlled substance, 8 for less than a gram of PG1, with 1 in a drug free zone, 3 cases for possession of 1-4 grams and 4 cases of 4-200 grams. There was 1 DWI 3rd or more case. There were 3 cases for engaging in organized criminal activity. Felony cases for burglary or theft included 2 cases for burglary of a habitation, 1 for burglary of a building, and 2 cases for burglary of a vehicle with 2 or more previous convictions. There were 3 credit/debit abuse cases, with one case for debit/credit abuse of the elderly. There was one case of evading arrest with a vehicle, and one case for unlawful possession of a firearm by a felon.

Crimes causing personal harm included one case of injury to child/disabled/elderly w/bodily injury/mental abuse. There was one case of assault on a public servant, 3 total cases for abandon/neglect of a child, 3 total cases for assaulting a family member, and one case of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon.

Sex crimes include one case of possession of child pornography, one case of indecency with a child/sexual contact, one case of sexual assault, and one case of aggravated sexual assault of a child.

Of the 45 cases, 4 were settled. Vickie Smith of Lampasas plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and was sentenced to 2 years probation plus costs/fines. Tonya Soria also plead guilty to the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram and was sentenced to 3 years probation plus court costs. Adrianna Banda of Harker Heights plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams and was sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs. Dennis Robinson, of Lampasas, on a charge of indecency with a child/sexual contact saw his charge changed to injury to a child and was sentenced to 6 years probation plus costs/fines.

The balance of the cases were reset or had trials set for a future date
