The regular session will begin immediately following the workshop session and will begin with presentations and proclamations. The Agenda includes a public hearing for citizen comments on an amendment to the fee schedule for Fire Department permits, inspections and licenses. There will be the second reading of ordinances, one to approve the Lampasas County Recycling program in the amount of \$36 annually and one to approve the rezoning of 1206 Mills St. and 1705 E. 4th St., consistent with the Lampasas Comprehensive Plan.

The City Manager's report will include information on 190 improvements, the Appraisal District, the Hostess House and the Council Workshop.

In new business there will be discussion and possible action including: renewal of the Chamber of Commerce Agreement, acceptance of the FY 2024-2029 CIP report, an increase in wholesale water rates related to capital expenditures, street closures in support of the Rockin' Rides and Smokin' Swing Car Show on July 9th at the Courthouse Square, the approval to lease 15 two-way radios and accessories in an amount not to exceed \$1200, obtaining fencing from United Rentals for the 580 Sports Complex not to exceed \$23,000, the purchase of a John Deere



3032E Utility Tractor for the Parks Department in the amount of \$25,000, changing the Fire Department fees for permits, licenses and inspections. The City Council will address the following in regards to the Solar Eclipse: 30 yard roll-off dumpsters in the amount of \$712 per container and \$34 per ton of waste, traffic management scope and expectations and approval of designated areas as viewing spots. The Agenda also includes some business with ATMOS Gas Company and a request from TxDOT to reduce the speed limit on 281S during construction from the Burnet County line to S. Main St.

June is National Homeownership Month, an opportunity for U.S. residents to reflect on the importance of the home and its role in their lives. Scammers often impersonate well-known or established companies and, after receiving initial payment, will disappear without even beginning the project. Desperate to establish communication, homeowners reach out to corporate or local offices for the company only to learn that the person who sold the job is not an employee.

Home improvement scams often begin with an unsolicited offer from a door-to-door salesperson or an ad posted on social media. While not all door-to-door solicitors are scammers, BBB recommends carefully evaluating any contractor utilizing this method to provide service, especially in the aftermath of damaging storms or other natural disasters. Some businesses may lack the proper insurance to cover unintentional damages to your home or yard during the project, use sub-quality materials that will not last, or lack licensing required to conduct repair or renovation work in your area.
