The Weather

High yesterday was 91° Low this morning was 58°
Look for one more nice day-not too humid-with high temperatures in the 90's.

Today: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 92°, with winds becoming east at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low near 65°. Winds will be E at 5-10 mph becoming SE in the evening.

Saturday: Skies will be sunny with a high temperature near 92°, winds will become E at 5-10 mph in the morning.

Saturday night: Clear with a low near 66°, and an east wind near 5 mph shifting E-SE in the evening.

Runoff Election

Monday June 12 is the last day for residents to register to vote for the Democratic Primary runoff election. If you did not vote in the republican primary, you can vote in this runoff. Election day will be July 14th.

Voters voting in the Democratic primary will decide the outcome in two statewide races. Most notably, State Sen. Royce West, is facing decorated Air Force veteran MJ Hegar in the Democratic primary for the U.S. Senate seat. Whoever wins will go on to face U.S. Sen. John Cornyn, R-Texas, in the fall. The other statewide Democratic primary runoff is for a seat on the Texas Railroad Commission, a regulatory agency that oversees the oil and natural gas industry.

Early voting will take place from June 29th-July 2nd, and July 6th-July 10th. Tuesday June 30th and Tuesday July 7th hours will be from 7am-7pm. All other days are from 8am-5pm. The early voting location is 407 S. Pecan #102 Lampasas.

Local Area Sales Tax Report

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced Wednesday \$690.4 million in local sales tax allocations for June 2020, 11.7% less than in June 2019. These allocations are based on April sales from businesses that report tax monthly. This is the steepest decline in allocations since September 2009.



In nearby Hamilton County, Evant received a check for \$4484.82, a whopping 53.31% over the same time period last year, but the city of Hamilton, saw a 21.58% decrease from \$65,011.69 to \$50,978.11 from last year to this year. In San Saba County, San Saba received a rebate for \$39,056.02, up just 3.59% from last year.

In Lampasas County, the City of Lometa was an increase during this time frame of 33.45% which garnered them a rebate check for \$7,413.83. Kempner saw an increase of 8.89% for a rebate of \$10,584.00, and the City of Lampasas saw an increase of 8.87% for a rebate of \$172,545.04.

Dr. Georgia Hay, Lampasas County Health Authority was in Lampasas Radio Studios this morning for a last update on the coronavirus situation.

There are no new cases in Lampasas, but the state has seen a spike in cases. Dr. Hay explained that the increase in cases now may be from Memorial Day Weekend when people were visiting. With the testing, and a short delay due to the state testing nursing home patients, by the time the information gets to the public it has probably been a few weeks.

While the vaccines are being developed (135 of them), it is her idea that we will see bumps and increases here and there, and that the virus may come and go, depending on the situations.

While we have flattened the curve, limiting gatherings, and the number of places you travel, will help keep the numbers down. That way, if you are infected, you will spread it to fewer people. She really really likes the idea of the cloth masks, so sick people don't spread the virus as much.

We had a listener ask how she felt about Lampasas having Spring Ho in a few weeks. She let us know that she was in the meeting with the Spring Ho Committee at their request. Dr. Hay also stated that the Spring Ho Committee is taking steps to be pro-active about social distancing, and providing hand sanitizer and making sure common areas are clean. However, having said that, there will be large groups gathering for events and we need to be careful. There will be a risk involved, and we will have people visiting from other areas of the state so be extra vigilant. Also, she said, "Spring Ho it totally optional", no one has to attend if they do not want to.

Outdoor Burning

A phone call to Judge Hoyer's office confirmed the fact that there are "Adopted Guidelines for Outdoor Burning", but there will not be any "Burn Ban". The rules, available at the county website include notifying the Sheriff's Office before burning, burning cannot take place after dark, a responsible person has to stay with the fire, and you should have some means of control directly proportionate to the burn. The wind cannot be 15 mph or greater, and burning must be conducted at least 300 feet from any structure containing sensitive receptors.
