The Weather

The Heat index got up to 98° yesterday

Today: Mostly cloudy skies this morning with gradual clearing and a high temperature near 94°. The heat index will top out near 100° this afternoon, and winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph.

Tonight: The sky should be mostly clear with a low around 73°. Winds will be S at 5-15 mph.

Sunday: Hot, sunny and up to 94° with the heat index near or over 100°. Light winds become NE in the afternoon.

Sunday Night: Overnight it gets down to 73° with mostly clear skies, and light and variable winds.

Monday: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 94° winds becoming N-NE at 5-10 mph

Town Hall Meeting on Livestock Ordinance

The City of Lampasas has scheduled a town hall meeting for Monday June 14th at 5:30pm in the City council Chambers in the Jack Calvert Municipal Building.

The Lampasas City Council was asked to draft an ordinance regulating livestock (to include chickens, goats, and pigs (pot-bellied pigs as well)).

The City of Lampasas Police Chief Sammy Bailey brought this issue to Council, did the research, and is drafting the ordinance. It is expected to pass.

However, the City Leaders are offering the public an opportunity for input this Monday, at 5:30pm scheduled before the Public Hearing on Annexation, which is at 6pm.

If you have an interest in this subject, this is the opportunity for residents to voice their concerns.



City of Lampasas Public Hearing

A notice was posted by the City of Lampasas that "A Public Hearing will be held on Monday June 14th. The hearing is about the Hillside Acres Subdivision, a 36.73 acre tract comprised of lots 1,2,3, and 4, Hillside Subdivision, in the ETJ of the city of Lampasas in Lampasas County. It is located on 580W near the sports complex. The city proposes to begin annexation proceedings to enlarge and extend the boundaries of the City of Lampasas to include this area.

Meetings Monday

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will meet Monday at 9am for a regular meeting. The Agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable & payroll, and requests for bids for gas & diesel delivered and aggregate for surface treatment. Also discussed will be a variance on a Kempner line crossing on CR 3210, and the fence project on CR 3270.

The Lampasas City Council will start their meetings on Monday with a town hall meeting concerning the new livestock/fowl ordinance being drafted by the city. A workshop session will follow discussion regarding the Covid-19 Pandemic, the livestock/fowl ordinance, the City Council Work Session Agenda, and updates on city projects.

The Lampasas City Council will meet beginning at 5:30pm on Monday for a special session to administer the oath of Office to newly elected mayor and members, reappointing the Municipal Court Judge and appointment of a mayor pro-tem.

This will be followed by a workshop session with. The regular session will begin with the swearing in of a new patrol officer with the Lampasas Police Dept., Kyle Molter. There will then be a public hearing to receive comments about 2 issues, a SUP for 206 N. Chestnut to place a storage building there, and for comments regarding the annexation of the Hillside Acre Subdivision. Also included in the meeting are the consent agenda, board and department reports, routine matters, and the City Manager's Operational report to include a report on the Court of Appeals, ERCOT and the Job Fair.

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Friday shows an early morning report of a Suspicious Vehicle in the 2300 block of 580W at 12:58am. There were 2 Domestic Disturbance reports in the 700 block of Brown St.; one at 1:10 AM, and one at 10:59am. There was also a domestic disturbance call in the 1900 block of 281S at 5:28am. A minor accident took place in the 1700 block of CTE at 8:45am. The evening shows a reported Disorderly Conduct in the 900 block of Campbell St. at 7:59pm, an assault by threat in the 100 block of S. Willis at 8:30pm, a domestic disturbance in the 600 block of S. Summer St. at 9:32pm, and a suspicious person was reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss at 10:28pm. There was one arrest as Jerry Worsham, 17, of Kempner was arrested in the 800 block of N. Gamel St. on a Lampasas Municipal Court Warrant for no drivers license at 10:44pm.

The Sheriff's Dept. Blotter shows Lometa with requests for welfare checks. In Kempner, officers dealt with civil matters, animal/livestock issues, reports of suspicious activity, and a noise complaint. Out in the county there were animal/livestock issues, medical calls, reported disturbances, and reports of suspicious activity. Deputies went into Cove on animal/livestock issues, an alarm call, code enforcement, and shots fired calls.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 52 year old Aurelio Coronado of Lampasas on 2 counts of assault on a family member w/previous convictions. Also arrested was 18 year old David Tellez III of Pflugerville for possession of marijuana less than 2 oz., and possession of a controlled substance PG 2, 1-4 grams.

In new business, there will be discussion and possible action on the SUP at 206 N. Chestnut, a replat of Lots 1 & 4, block 10, East Lampasas Addition, discussion about the final Plat of Cloud Street, for Pyrotecnico Fireworks to conduct the Spring Ho Fireworks display, a request by the Spring Ho committee for \$500 from the city for Spring Ho, and disposing of a street sweeper.

Council will then go into Executive Session, relating to receiving and evaluating financial information with a business that the city is conducting Economic Development Negotiations. Council will then return to regular session for action on executive session.

Changes at Lampasas ISD



Dana Holcomb will be moving into Dr. Bott's role as the assistant superintendent, as Dr. Bott has resigned to take another position. Mr. Holcomb has worked for Lampasas ISD for 27 years. The last ten he has served as principal at Lampasas Middle School. Additionally, he worked at Lampasas High School for eight years as a teacher and coach before accepting the assistant principal position at Lampasas Middle School in 2002. He is excited about the opportunity to serve the district in his new capacity. Wes Graham, who has been part of the Kline Whitis Elementary family since 2010 will be moving to Lampasas Middle School as Principal. Leanne Bobo, of Lampasas Middle School will move to Kline Whitis Elementary as Principal, and candidates will be considered for the Assistant Principal position at the middle school.

Beware of the Heat

During extremely hot and humid weather, your body's ability to cool itself is challenged. If the body heats too rapidly to cool itself properly, or when too much fluid or salt is lost through dehydration, or sweating, body temperature rises and you may experience a heat-related illness. It is important to know the symptoms of excessive heat exposure and what to do.

Heat cramps may be the first sign of heat-related illness, and may lead to heat exhaustion or stroke.

Symptoms: Painful muscle cramps and spasms usually in legs and abdomen, heavy sweating.

Heat Exhaustion symptoms are; Heavy sweating, weakness, cool/pale/clammy skin, fast/weak pulse, possible muscle cramps, dizziness, nausea or vomiting, fainting.

What to do: Move person to a cooler environment, lay person down and loosen clothing, apply cool/wet cloths to as much of the body as possible, fan or move victim to air conditioned room, offer sips of water.

*If person vomits more than once, seek immediate medical attention

Heat stroke symptoms are; Altered mental state, one or more of the following symptoms: throbbing headache, confusion, nausea, dizziness, shallow breathing. Body temperature above 103°F, hot, red, dry or moist skin, Rapid and strong pulse, faints, loses consciousness.

What to do: Heat stroke is a severe medical emergency. Call 911 or get the victim to a hospital immediately. Delay can be fatal. Move the victim to a cooler, preferably air-conditioned, environment.

Reduce body temperature with cool cloths or bath.

Use fan *if heat index temperatures are below the high 90s*. A fan can make you hotter at higher temperatures
