Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met Monday morning for a regularly scheduled meeting.

A Distinguished Service Award was given to the Lampasas County Historical Commission by the Texas Historical Commission. "These guys do a great job." said County Judge Randy Hoyer.

A request bid for gas and diesel delivery and for aggregate for surface treatment were approved unanimously.

A proposal to allow precincts to create a parking lot where the old jail was as soon as possible was approved. "The goal is to complete it before Spring Ho." said Commissioner Jamie Smart.

City Council Meeting

The Lampasas City Council met Monday evening for regularly scheduled meetings.

During the Joint Workshop Session, the Capital Improvement Committee report showed 107 active projects which include phase

2 of the Business Park, and street improvements. Zoning regulation updates, electric system modeling, the Western St. pedestrian bridge, and upgrading flood control dams were also included in the report.

At the Workshop Session, the FY2024 Budget was discussed briefly. Presentations from organizations took place during the workshop session as well and included presentations from Derrick Berrios of the Lampasas County Higher Education Center (LCHEC), Keith Sledd of Heart of Texas Defense Alliance (HOTDA), and Jim Lindeman of Hill Country 100 Club, among others.

The consent agenda, which included approving the second reading of an ordinance to approve the Lampasas County Recycling program in the amount of \$36.00 annually, and an ordinance to rezone 79.971 acres; commonly known as 1206 Mills Street and 1705 E. 4th St as presented in the Lampasas Comprehensive Plan were approved without any changes.

The Lampasas Central Appraisal District (LCAD) will conduct a public hearing on their FY 2024 Budget on June 22nd at 8:30am at the LCAD office, 109 E. 5th St.

It's That Time of Year

It looks like the heat of summer has arrived. With 100° temperatures and even higher heat indexes forecast beginning this week, we'll take a look at some heat-related watches and warnings. (Last year our first 100° day was May 7th with a high of 102°. We have not had a 100° day this year).

The National Weather Service points out that the combination of hot weather and high humidity can quickly cause heat-related illness to set in, and issues advisories for high heat to warn residents of the dangers.

A **Heat Advisory** is issued when the heat index value is expected to reach 100 to 104 degrees in Texas within the next 12 to 24 hours. A Heat Advisory may be issued for lower criteria if it is early in the season or during a multi-day heat wave.

An **Excessive Heat Watch** is issued when conditions are favorable for an excessive heat event in the next 12 to 48 hours.

An **Excessive Heat Warning/Advisory** is issued when an excessive heat event is expected in the next 36 hours. These alerts are issued when an excessive heat event is occurring, is imminent, or has a very high probability of occurrence.

Stay Safe! Drink plenty of water, wear light colored loose clothing, take breaks in the AC, and avoid spending time outdoors during the hottest part of the day.
