The Haze in the Air

Yesterday the National Weather Service listed Lampasas as having fog/mist/smoke/haze in the air. According to a story on KXAN's weather page, the haze is due to a combination of 'humidity haze' and smoke from agricultural burns in Mexico. When the two factors combine, it can worsen air quality.

The closest air quality reading to Lampasas is the Killeen/Waco area at AirNow.gov, and it is at a 72. This is in the 'moderate' category which reads 'Air quality is acceptable; however, there may be some health concern for a small number of unusually sensitive individuals'.

ERCOT Issues Weather Watch'

According to a story on KXXV, ERCOT has issued a 'Weather Watch' from Thursday June 15th to Wednesday June 21st due to the forecasted high temperatures in Texas through next week.

A Weather Watch is defined by ERCOT as "an advance notification of forecasted significant weather with high demand." "Grid conditions are normal, but due to forecasted conditions, operating reserves may be lower."

"Last year, ERCOT set 11 new peak demand records, surpassing 80 GWs for the first time ever. The current record of 80,148 MWs was set on July 20, 2022." (cont'd on back)


