## District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on June 4th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 38 cases were brought to the court with 31 cases involving men, and 7 cases involving women.

There were 13 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/ PG1; There were 9 cases for under 1 gram, and two cases each for 1-4 grams and 4-200 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG2 less than a gram. There were 6 DWI cases, three for engaging in organized criminal activity, and one each for burglary, harassment of a public servant, illegal dumping, disclosing intimate pictures, and one for stalking.

In cases involving personal harm, there were 2 assault cases, one for intoxication assault, and one for indecency. Six cases were settled with Nathan Taylor having his indictment amended from intoxication assault to assault w/deadly weapon, and receiving 4 years probation plus fines and court costs. Joel Hopkins received 4 years probation for each of his cases, one for possession of a controlled substance PG1/1-4 grams, and the other was unauthorized use of a motor vehicle. Dorothy Bowles received 4 years probation plus costs and a fine for the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Eddie Mc Clinton received 4 days jail plus court costs and a fine for possession of a controlled substance PG1. Jesse O'Neal saw his probation continued w/ SAFPF as a stipulation for the charges of possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams, and possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials.

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on June 11th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 17 cases were brought to the court with 14 cases involving men, and 3 cases involving women.

There were 8 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/ PG1. There were 5 cases for less than 1 gram, one for 1-4 grams and two for 4-200 grams. There were two cases for DWI.

There were 2 assault cases, 2 indecency cases and one each for prostitution, endangering a child, and unauthorized use of a motor vehicle cases.

Three cases were settled with Abraham Rodriguez pleading guilty to engaging in organized criminal activity and receiving a sentence of 5 years probation plus fines and costs. Daniel Chapman plead guilty to endangering a child/criminal negligence and received a sentence of 3 years probation plus a fine and court costs. Clara Hysell was sentenced to 3 years probation plus a fine and court costs for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. All other cases were rescheduled or set for jury trials

## Streaming Allowed for UIL High School Football Games this Year

According to KWTX, on Tuesday the UIL Legislative Council voted to allow Texas high school football games to be streamed online. This following a season where the UIL allowed high school football games to be broadcast on live television and online due to the Covid-19 pandemic and limited capacity in stadiums around the state.

According to Dave Campbell's Texas Football, the measure, which was voted out of the policy committee, passed the final legislative council by a clear majority

— but not unanimous — vote.

The changes approved Tuesday “would allow for UIL member schools to permit the live webcast of a regular season football game on a Friday night.”
