## From the Lampasas County Central Appraisal District

*From the Lampasas Central Appraisal District:*

"The Lampasas Central Appraisal District has mailed notices to all property owners whose value has increased. Because of the continued dramatic real estate market in Texas, most people have received a notice. Chief Appraiser Susan Jones stated " We keep hearing that values are beginning to slow or decrease, but we are not yet seeing lower sales prices."

With a Property Value Study looming on the horizon, the need for increases is necessary. Failure of the study done by the State Comptroller on market values may mean a loss of state funding for local schools. "We have seen significant increases in sales of homes and land for the past three years. We are required by law to be within 5% of state assigned values in order for the local schools to receive full state funding," said Jones.

"There is some good news for local taxpayers," Jones stated. " Persons with a homestead exemption are limited to a 10% increase in taxable value from the prior year, and that will help to restrict major increases for homeowners. Also, for homesteaded properties whose owners are over 65 or disabled, their school taxes are capped so nothing will change for them on their school taxes, regardless of the value changes."

Also, a hopeful change in law is being debated by the State Legislature with a likely increase in the school homestead exemption and a reduction in school tax rates (Compression). Those potential changes will ameliorate the proposed market value increases.

A protest form was included with value notices. "We just want to get the values correct so that the local schools will be fully funded, said Jones. "If taxpayers have evidence that their value is incorrect, we will gladly correct those values. Good types of evidence to bring to the district are recent purchase paperwork, recent fee appraisals, or information that shows problem areas that would negatively impact sales prices."

AdventHealth Central Texas tells us that dehydration is the usual cause of heat related illness. They share that people really need to pay attention to early symptoms of heat exhaustion that may include extreme thirst, muscle cramps and excessive sweating. If you experience these symptoms, you need to move to a cooler area, make sure you have light colored, loose clothing and sip cool water. Be sure to seek medical help if your symptoms don't improve.

Heat Stroke is evidenced by confusion , dizziness, stupor, a high fever, a rapid heart rate and warm dry skin, among other symptoms. If you or someone around you experiences this, call 911, move the person to a cooler area and cool with water or ice.

If you find yourself in extreme heat, find some air conditioning, avoid strenuous activities, wear light clothing, check on those you know, watch for symptoms of heat related illnesses and never leave people or pets in a closed car.

## Governor Abbott Sending Resources to Panhandle

The panhandle town of Perryton was hit hard by tornadoes yesterday.

Reports say the tornado hit the northwest part of town, then traveled through the town traveling southeast to the other side of the community. Pictures and video showed downed power lines, many destroyed buildings and a mobile home park that was hard hit with about 30 homes destroyed. There were 3 deaths and dozens of injuries, and the hospital was working last night without power. Some patients were transferred to trauma centers.

"The State of Texas is swiftly deploying critical emergency response resources to provide all necessary support and assistance to protect Texans and help those impacted by tornadoes in Perryton," said Governor Abbott. "I ask all Texans to join Cecilia and me in praying for our fellow Texans who have been impacted by this horrific storm. Stay safe, Texas."

At the Governor's direction, TDEM has deployed the following state resources to support tornado response operations: Texas Department of Transportation, Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service, Texas A&M Forest Service, Texas Department of State Health Services Emergency Medical Task Force, Texas A&M Urban Search and Rescue teams, Texas Parks and Wildlife Game Wardens, TCEQ, and the Texas DPS.

today, and the temperature is supposed to stay over 100° for the foreseeable future.

The National Weather Service (NWS) states that people can be seriously affected if precautions are not taken. Residents also need to be aware of not staying out in the heat for prolonged periods of time. The issuing of a heat warning will also alert hospitals and law enforcement officials and this will also activate programs to check on the elderly and the home-bound.
