The Weather



High yesterday was 106° The low this morning was 77°

The heat index reached 115° yesterday at 5:15pm.

Lampasas County is under an excessive Heat Warning until 8pm tonight

Today: Sunny and hot with a high near 104° and a possible heat index of 115°. Wind will be E near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy with a low around 75° and a 30% chance of showers and storms. Wind will be SE near 10-15 mph shifting N-NE overnight with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Thursday: Mostly sunny, with a high near 97° and a heat index near 107°. E-SE wind will be 5-10 mph.

Thursday Night: The temperature will drop to near 76° with mostly cloudy skies and a SE wind near 10 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny with a high near 97° and SE wind near 10 mph gusting to 20mph.

Friday Night: Partly cloudy skies and a low near 77° with S-SE wind near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph. There is a 30% chance of showers and storms.

Kempner Water Supply Alert

Yesterday evening at 8:07pm, Kempner Water Supply published an alert that their facilities at their water plant, the 195 pump station and the Central Texas Water Supply had lost power. (We since found out the Central Texas Water Supply has back-up generators so they were not affected). The loss of power, Kempner Water was told, was a result of rolling blackouts.

Some investigating this morning revealed that the rolling blackouts were generated by the Bartlett Electric Cooperative, which powers those locations as well as part of Killeen. Bruce Sorenson, General Manager for Kempner Water said the rolling blackouts seem to have started near 6pm and ended at 11pm and there was no advance warning this was going to happen.

The water service is fine as of this morning; however, Mr. Sorenson shared that some of the storage tanks are not quite full and asked that customers conserve if they can for the next 1-2 days so that the storage capacity can recover.

Kempner water has reached out to the Bartlett Electric Cooperative to find out if the rolling blackouts may continue, and we have reached out also, and there has been no word from the Bartlett Electric Coop at this time.

In Lampasas Radio Studios

Ryan Ward, Lampasas Assistant City Manager visited Lampasas Radio studios this morning to visit with Ronnie Witcher this morning.

They spoke about the Kempner Water Alert, because the City of Lampasas gets their water from Kempner Water Supply Corporation. Mr. Ward assured our listeners, though, that the City has storage tanks that they utilize. So, even if there is a problem and getting water from Kempner Water is an issue, the City of Lampasas has considerable storage capacity. Mr. Ward says this will last the city for days, not hours, and the city will advise customers if needed.

The Assistant City Manager also shared that city water customers need to be aware that with this heat, the evaporation rate on the bodies of water that we depend on for our water is quite significant, and to conserve where we can.

Mr. Ward shared with Ronnie Witcher that things are gearing up for Spring Ho and that it will be all hands on deck for the festival. He also shared that the Naruna Rd. intersection is open again, and that the city is getting ready to do an asphalt overlay on 2nd St. near Pecan St.
