The Heat Index in Lampasas reached 112° at 2:15 yesterday


Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies with gradual clearing and a high near 98°, with a heat index near 109°. There is a 30% chance of showers this afternoon. Wind will be E-SE today near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies, and the low will get down to about 76° overnight. There is a 20% chance of precipitation. The wind will be E-SE near 5-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Friday: Look for mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 98° and a heat index of 109°. Wind will be SE near 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a 20% chance of showers and a low near 75°. S-SE wind near 10 mph.

Saturday: Mostly sunny skies with the high temperature near 100°. The wind will be S near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. Saturday Night: Partly cloudy skies and the low will bottom out near 78°. Wind will be S near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.



District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on June 16th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 43 cases were brought to the court with 34 cases involving men and 9 cases involving women. There were 5 defendants that failed to appear: Abraham Cabrera of Plano on the charge of burglary of a habitation, Anthony Rivera and Keith West for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram, Melissa Jackson of Lampasas for tampering with evidence, and Hailey Evans on the charge of for possession of a controlled substance PG1, 1-4 grams.

There were 17 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 7 cases for possession less than a gram, 6 cases for possession of 1-4 grams, and 2 cases for possession PG1 4-200 grams. There were two cases of manufacture/delivery of a controlled substance PG1/4-200 grams. There were 3 DWI cases.

There were 5 cases for burglary, two cases each for bail jumping/FTA and tampering with evidence. There was one case each for engaging in organized criminal activity, evading arrest, theft, unlawful possession of a firearm, illegal dumping and forgery (enhanced).

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 2 cases for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and one case each for assault of a family member, staking and violating a bond/protective order. There was 1 case of aggravated sexual assault of a child, one case for continuous sexual abuse of a child 14 or under, and 1 case for failing to register as a sex offender.

Of the 43 cases 14 were resolved including Joseph Wyatt pleading guilty to manufacture/deliver of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams, and was sentenced to 8 years probation. Miguel Perez plead guilty to violating a bond/protective order and was sentenced to 10 years TDCJ with 10 years probated with the condition of SAFPF and court costs; on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram, (cont'd on back)

The Blotter



The Lampasas Police blotter for Wednesday shows a suspicious person reported in the 1800 block of 281S at 5:06am, and a disturbance in the 1000 block of Mill St. at 10:27am. The afternoon shows an assault reported in the 300 block of N. Park St. at 1:35pm. There were 2 domestic disturbance calls in the 700 block of Brown St., one at 5:2pm and one at 6:30pm. A criminal trespass was reported in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. at 10:50pm, and at that location, Storm Hamilton, 22, of Lampasas was arrested for criminal trespass. There was a domestic disturbance reported in the 500 block of S. Hackberry St. at 11:43pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. Blotter for Wednesday shows Kempner with civil matters, reports of suspicious activity, an accident, an alarm call, a requested welfare check, medical calls and livestock issues. Out in the county there were utility problems, civil matters, a reported identity theft, livestock issues, reports of suspicious activity, a sex offense and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on reports of suspicious activity.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 44 year old Christopher Shaw of Evant on a bench warrant, 52 year old Felix Ybarra of Lampasas on a probation violation and a 61 year old Lampasas resident on the charge of health care fraud.

(cont'd from front) Mr. Perez saw his probation adjudicated, was found guilty and was sentenced to 30 days county jail with credit for days served. Adam McNamee, on the charge of for possession of a controlled substance PG, 1-4 grams was sentenced to 15 years TDCJ. Kimberly Delacruz, on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1, less than a gram was sentenced to 10 years TDCJ, with 10 years probated and the condition of SAFPF. Fidencio Maldonado plead guilty and was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ on the charge of failure to comply as a sex offender, and on the charge of aggravated sexual assault of a child, Mr. Maldonado saw his probation continued. Brian Zielinski had a motion to dismiss on his charge of stalking.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.
