Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a high temperature near 99° and a heat index as high as 105°. Wind will be S-SE near 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies tonight and the low temperature will be near 76°. Wind will be S overnight at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

The Lampasas County Tax Assessor/Collector's Office received word that all Tx DMV systems are down at this time. This affects all online and all in-person vehicle related services.

This is a statewide issue and the local office in the Lampasas County Annex Building is unable to process titles or yearly vehicle registrations at this time. There has been no word about when the system may come back online. Additionally, all 16 TxDMV Regional Service Centers are closed today.

There is staff available this morning at the local office to answer questions. They advise residents to contact them on Monday about transactions and to see if the system is back online.

Lampasas County will be paving County Road 2200 beginning next Tuesday, June 27th at 8am. They advise residents in that area to plan on delays. With no unexpected complications, this paving project should be finished by the end of the day Tuesday.

Bipartisan Bill Targets Emerging Drug Threat

Yesterday the US Senate passed bi-partisan legislation to help combat the rise in illicit use of the dangerous animal tranquilizer xylazine, or tranq. Xylazine, which has been nicknamed "tranq," is a powerful sedative used by veterinarians. Although the tranquilizer is often combined with other drugs like fentanyl and Xanax, it is not an opioid, and cannot be reversed with Narcan. Tranq, also known as the "zombie drug" has gruesome side effects, causing large wounds that will not heal.

The (TRANQ) Research Act takes steps to enhance understanding of tranq and other novel synthetic drugs, develop new tests for detection, and establish partnerships with front-line entities that are often the first points of contact with new street drugs. Texas law enforcement officials have recently detected this drug in illicit fentanyl supplies, and it has led to several deaths in the state.

On April 12, the Office of National Drug Control Policy declared fentanyl-adulterated or -associated xylazine an "emerging threat" to the country, the first time in history a substance formally received this declaration.
