The new business agenda will include discussion and possible action on the following: pool lap swim fees, approval of funds from the joint use facility account to purchase and install a generator at the Highway 195 Pump Station that supports the Lampasas and Kempner water supplies and the Lampasas Central Appraisal District 2024 Budget. Also included in new business is discussion and possible action to accept a proposal from Central Texas Valet in the amount of \$20,000 for parking management, accepting a proposal from Lite & Barricade for traffic control management, and from Street Smart for portable security cameras in an amount not to exceed \$16,000 for the April 2024 Solar Eclipse Event.

The Council will then go into Executive Session relating to the authority of public power utility governing bodies to deliberate regarding competitive matters-utilities.

Council will then reconvene for action on executive session items.
