The Weather

Lampasas County is under an Excessive Heat warning until tomorrow at 8pm.

Today: Look for sunny skies with a high near 105°. S-SW wind will be near 10-15 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies with the low dropping to about 77° by morning. Wind will be S near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 103°. Look for wind to be S-SW near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Wednesday Night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 74° and S wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Thursday: Sunny skies and the high will be near 101° with S-SW wind near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 73° and S-SE wind near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Lampasas County Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court met yesterday at 9:00am. The application for PR 3418 was approved as well as an interlocal agreement with Burnet County. The TAC (Texas Association of Counties) health insurance was approved at a 6.5% increase and the increase in County Clerk recording fees was approved.

Following discussion of the Lampasas Central Appraisal District budget the motion did not carry forward with a 4:1 vote against. No action was taken on matters involving the Lampasas County Burn Ban and the Presentation of the 2022 financial audit was not provided due to unavailability.

On matters involving the Hill country Transit district this decision

brought discussion of all court members. This is concerning the loss of federal funding for the HOP. No action followed and it was moved the agenda for the next regular meeting. Before the meeting adjourned the judge sent out a reminder for the Fourth of July employee picnic and service recognition for Thursday on the Courthouse Square.

Lampasas City Council Meeting



The Lampasas City Council met yesterday beginning with the workshop session at 5:30pm. During the workshop session, presentations were given including Derrick Berrios, (LHEC), the Lampasas County Museum Board, and a presentation regarding city pools and lap swim fees. One public comment was brought requesting the fee for lap swimming be reduced to \$25 from \$40.

The Council approved the motion to amend Appendix A "Fee Schedule" Chapter 38 Fire Prevention and Protection, Article 1, Fees for Permits, Inspections and Licenses. Singleton, Clark, and Company was approved to perform the Fiscal Year 2023 Audit in the amount of \$45,000.

Approval was requested for funds to allow Central Texas Valet to secure parking management for the Solar Eclipse Event on April 8, 2024 in the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00. This topic also included allowing staff the opportunity to negotiate with the Central Texas Valet regarding staffing needs and logistics, including barricades and lights for this event. No action was taken and they agreed to come back to this decision.

There was discussion of the city using the joint use facility account to install an emergency generator at the 195 Pump Station, a facility critical in the delivery of water to KWSC and the City of Lampasas. This was requested in a letter from Bruce Sorenson, General Manager of Kempner Water supply to the Lampasas City Manager. Originally the amount was not to exceed \$400,000.00. A presentation to increase the price to less than \$500,000.00 was made and the board did not consider the generator presented, (at a cost of \$514,000). No motion carried. Regarding the pool fees, no action was taken by council; therefore the fees will remain the same.

No action was taken regarding the LCAD FY 2024 Budget as presented and there was no action taken in executive session.

The City of Kempner will hold a scheduled City Council Meeting today at 6:00pm at 12280 E. Hwy 190 in Kempner.

Included on the agenda is the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee.
