On Flying Out Of Austin..



We get occasional statistics and notices out of the
ustin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). Most of it is just
promotional but we noticed this one that we thought might be
useful for our readers.

The busiest months for air travel out of ABIA (actually most of us
still call it Bergstrom) are May thru July. If you have to travel in
those months, you better allow 2 hours of time in line at the airport.
The slowest and least crowded months are January and February.
Yeh, who wants to travel when it's cold! But then, if you could
work it out that way, the airport and the planes are far less crowded.
The other thing is, what are the busiest flights?

The champion of busy airlines out of ABIA is Southwest Airlines.
They had well over 2.3 million passengers so far this year. That
compared to number two, American Airlines with over 1.2 million,
United Airlines had 990 thousand, then Delta 895 thousand,
Frontier Airlines had 256 thousand and on down with about 19
different airlines servicing the airport.

Some of the international airlines that carry passengers out of ABIA
include exotic flyers like Scandinavian, Lufthansa. AeroMexico,
Norwegian, British Airways and Air Canada. They don't have as
many flights, or passengers, as the U.S. airlines, but they do take a
good many vacationers back to their countries.

Altogether, it looks like roughly 1.6 million people will fly in and
out of ABIA just this month.

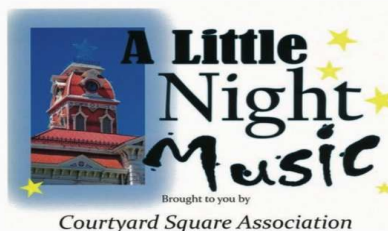

Lampasas Police Dept blotter for Thursday shows a criminal trespass in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss at 8:17am. A burglary of a motor vehicle was reported in the 200 block of W. Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. for Thursday shows Lometa with a missing person report, and illegal dumping call, a juvenile probation call and a livestock issue. Kempner had a welfare check, an animal problem, and a civil matter. Out in the county there were accidents, and a report of a disturbance. Deputies went into Cove on medical calls, suspicious activity and a structure fire.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. log shows a pursuit at 3:38pm initiated in Lampasas County on Hwy 281, with a small black Nissan and a female driver.. Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept stated when asked that this was a Burnet County matter. Lampasas Radio attempted to reach law enforcement in Burnet County, and were told that the chase began in Lampasas county and little else. What we were able to find out shows that the speed in the pursuit reached over 100mph, and went through the city of Burnet, and ended near the intersection of FM 1855 and Hwy 281S north of Marble Falls.

The Burn Ban is lifted until Mon., July 1 at 7pm.
