## Commissioners' Court

**The Lampasas County Commissioners Court** will meet Monday July 11<sup>th</sup> for a regular meeting at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom at the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda to include monthly departmental reports from the County Offices. The Agenda also includes accounts payable and payroll, a Roadway Development and Maintenance Agreement for the Bluffs at Yancey Creek that was tabled on June 27<sup>th</sup>, the Final Plat Part A of the Bluffs at Yancey Creek, Bond Approval for Dan Hause, the adoption of an Order granting a Public Health and Safety Exemption for contracting with an ambulance service for Lampasas County and authorizing the Judge to negotiate with interested providers, an award bid for Gas & Diesel, and an award bid for Aggregate Surface Treatment for which no bids were received.

## Lampasas City Council

**Lampasas City Council** will have regular meetings on Monday, July 11<sup>th</sup> with the workshop session beginning at 5:30pm. The agenda for the workshop session includes a presentation from Derrick Berrios from LCHEC, a review of the City of Lampasas Personnel Policy Section 8.00, updates regarding city projects, discussion regarding the Community Garden Rainwater Collection System, discussion regarding the Hanna Spring Wall at Campbell Park, a fiscal year 2022/2023 budget update and a discussion regarding Lampasas County procurement of EMS Services.

The regular session will begin at 6pm and the agenda includes the consent agenda, the Information Technology Annual Report, the City Manager's operational report to include information on the business park, a relief route, short term rentals, and a pole barn. In new business the agenda includes discussion and possible action on the following: the TxDOT Highway 281S right of way acquisition from the City of Lampasas and cost to cure reimbursement of \$22,577, regarding a proposal from Schneider Engineering for SCADA Network design and installation in the amount of \$64,530, purchasing acoustic panels for the Calvert Meeting Room to minimize echo, the renewal of the City's health insurance coverage for City Employees with Scott & White health plan for the October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023 plan year and authorize the City Manager to execute related documents, and a subscription to the myLIBRO library app.

## TxDOT Holding Meetings Regarding 183 North

The Texas Department of Transportation invites the public to participate in a virtual or in-person meeting for the proposed US 183 N widening project in Lampasas County. To view the virtual public meeting, visit the TxDOT website at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) and search "US 183 Lampasas County" or scan the QR code above on Tuesday, July 12, 2022; materials will be posted by noon. Sign up for email updates on the project while online by clicking the subscribe button in the top right corner of the webpage. In-Person Public Meetings will be held at the following locations and times:

The purpose of the project is to improve the safety and mobility of US 183. The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way in some locations. Construction timing is not yet known.

The limits of the proposed project will be from just south of Lometa at US 190 to just north of US 281 in the city of Lampasas, as shown in the map below.

The proposed US 183 widening project includes the following:

- \* Adding additional pavement width where necessary, for a total of four travel lanes, two in each direction
- \* Dividing the roadway with a flush center median for making left-hand turning movements
- \* Improving shoulders and guardrails
- \* Improving drainage by upgrading culverts
- \* Reducing slope (steepness) of ditches

## TxDOT and a 10-Year Transportation Plan

TxDOT is seeking public input on the draft 2023 Unified Transportation Program (UTP), the state's 10-year transportation plan. The UTP guides the development of projects around Texas to improve safety, address congestion and connectivity, and preserve roadways for Texas drivers. In addition to highway projects, the UTP addresses public transportation, maritime, aviation, rail, freight and international trade, and bicycle and pedestrian connectivity.

"The Unified Transportation Program is TxDOT's road map to developing projects across the state," said Executive Director Marc Williams. "It is important to work with our transportation partners and hear from the public to guide transportation improvements that address congestion and enhance safety across our state."

The public comment period for the draft 2023 UTP begins Friday, July 8, 2022, and ends Monday, Aug. 8, 2022, at 4 p.m. (CST). Various methods to comment will be posted to the UTP Public Involvement webpage. The presentations and recordings for the previous public meeting and hearing will be available for viewing on the UTP Public Involvement webpage.

TxDOT works with its transportation partners to identify projects to be included in the UTP. Public comments and feedback are also very important in developing the plan. Available in English and Spanish, the UTP Fact Sheet can be found on the same TxDOT.gov webpage and provides an overview of the program. The Texas Transportation Commission approves the UTP in accordance with Texas state law every August during the commission meeting and publishes the approved UTP on TxDOT.gov
