The heat index reached 102° in Lampasas yesterday.

Hot and getting hotter...It will be hot and humid with temperatures ranging from the upper 90's to near 106°. Heat indices in excess of 105° will be felt area wide, especially on Saturday, with some areas seeing a 110° heat index. Additional heat advisories/warnings are expected to be issued on Sunday. The heat continues through next week.




Dr. Georgia Hay shared with Lampasas
Radio this morning that Lampasas now has a total of 58 cases with 24 active, and 1 in the hospital

(different patient from yesterday).

The State website lists Lampasas as having 32 cases. Governor Abbott listed 100 more counties required to suspend elective surgeries. These counties do not include Lampasas (or Trauma Service Area L). The Trauma Service Areas that are now included in the proclamation are areas: J, K, M, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, and V.

# Falling Apart from the Inside?

Governor Abbott issued an executive order requiring Texans to wear masks in public last week, giving counties the opportunity to opt out if the county had a low number of COVID-19 cases.



Montgomery, Gillespie, Kerr, and Wood counties are not enforcing the order, including the east Texas Towns of Hawkins and Winnsboro.

Now, the Republican parties of 6 Texas counties have censured the Governor, which simply means it is a formal statement of disapproval. Last weekend Ector County (Odessa) voted to censure Governor Abbott, as well as Harrison County and Llano County. According to an article in the Texas Tribune, Hood County passed a resolution censuring the Governor unanimously. Montgomery and Denton Counties also approved a resolution of censure.

The Texas Tribune offered this: "Most of the county party resolutions censuring Abbott request that the delegates to the state GOP convention consider doing the same when they meet next week. While party rules allow delegates to do so by a majority vote, what is less clear is the process by which the issue would be brought to the convention floor.

In any case, a censure would be largely symbolic. If approved at the state level, the resolution would allow the Texas GOP to take sides against Abbott in an intraparty contest and to withhold financial support for him. Abbott is not up for reelection until 2022, and his campaign is far better-funded than the party.



With the number of cases spiking; 9,782 new cases were reported on July 9. There are 9,689 Texan s Hospitalized with COVID-19. The decision gets more difficult. And in the cases of nursing homes and child care businesses and facilities, the officials do not share everything they know, most times because they say it would violate someone's privacy. There is truth to that, but without all the information, how can Texas expect parents to make an informed decision?
