The Weather

High yesterday was 97° Low this morning was 74°

The heat index reached 102° in Lampasas yesterday. Hot and getting hotter...It will be hot and humid with temperatures ranging from the upper 90's to near 106°. Heat indices in excess of 105° will be felt area wide, especially on Saturday, with some areas seeing a 110° heat index. Additional heat advisories/warnings are expected to be issued on Sunday. The heat continues through next week.

Today: Mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 98°. Winds will be S near 10 mph. The Heat index could reach 103°.

Tonight: Clear with a low near 75°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Skies will be sunny with a high temperature near 101°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-10 mph.

Saturday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 78°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

Sunday: Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 106°. Wind will be W-SW at 5-10 mph.

Sunday night: Mostly clear with a low near 79° and S-SE wind near 5 mph.

Monday: Sunny with a high near 106° and SW wind at 5-10 mph.



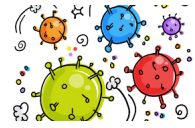
COVID-19 Update

Lampasas County Health Authority

Dr. Georgia Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that Lampasas now has a total of 58 cases with 24 active, and 1 in the hospital (different patient from yesterday).

The State website lists Lampasas as having 32 cases.

Governor Abbott listed 100 more counties required to suspend elective surgeries. These counties do not include Lampasas (or Trauma Service Area L). The Trauma Service Areas that are now included in the proclamation are areas: J, K, M, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, and V.



Falling Apart from the Inside?

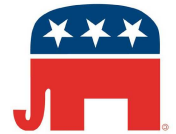
Governor Abbott issued an executive order requiring Texans to wear masks in public last week, giving counties the opportunity to opt out if the county had a low number of COVID-19 cases. 78 counties have accepted that offer, and some local governments won't enforce the order for various reasons.

Montgomery, Gillespie, Kerr, and Wood counties are not enforcing the order, including the east Texas Towns of Hawkins and Winnsboro.

Now, the Republican parties of 6 Texas counties have censured the Governor, which simply means it is a formal statement of disapproval. Last weekend Ector County (Odessa) voted to censure Governor Abbott, as well as Harrison County and Llano County. According to an article in the Texas Tribune, Hood County passed a resolution censuring the Governor unanimously. Montgomery and Denton Counties also approved a resolution of censure.

The Texas Tribune offered this: "Most of the county party resolutions censuring Abbott request that the delegates to the state GOP convention consider doing the same when they meet next week. While party rules allow delegates to do so by a majority vote, what is less clear is the process by which the issue would be brought to the convention floor.

In any case, a censure would be largely symbolic. If approved at the state level, the resolution would allow the Texas GOP to take sides against Abbott in an intraparty contest and to withhold financial support for him. Abbott is not up for reelection until 2022, and his campaign is far better-funded than the party.

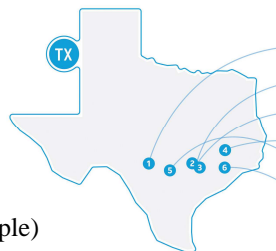

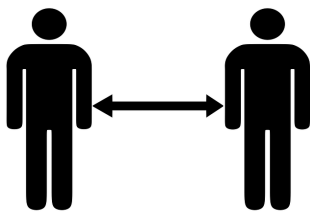

The Blotter.

Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Thursday shows a minor accident in the 1700 block of CTE at 11:53am. The evening shows a reported theft in the 300 block of N. Key at 7:56pm. A disturbance was called in from the 100 block of W. 8th St. at 9:03pm, then a criminal mischief was reported in the 700 block of W. Ave E at 10:27pm. A suspicious vehicle was reported in the 1400 block of 281S at 11:57pm.

Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. Blotter for Thursday shows Lometa with a civil matter. Kempner also had civil matters, as well as reported threats, an abandoned vehicle, and a medical call. Out in the county there was a report of criminal mischief, and an accident. Deputies went into Cove on a medical call.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 19 year old Angel Molina of Houston on 16 out of county charges, all from Burnet County.

Decisions Decisions

The City of Houston canceled the Republican Convention that was to be held there.

This is an example of the decisions parents are having to make about sending their children to school or child care and how safe it is.

The Texas Tribune states that a UT/Texas Politics Project poll found 65% of registered voters think it is unsafe to send kids back to school.

Is Texas ready?

In Lampasas, parents filled out a survey stating if they wanted remote learning. Lampasas Radio spoke to a parent of 2 elementary age children, and she indicated it was a difficult decision. School age children can bring the virus home to a family member that is high-risk.

With the number of cases spiking; 9,782 new cases were reported on July 9. There are 9,689 Texan s Hospitalized with COVID-19. The decision gets more difficult. And in the cases of nursing homes and child care businesses and facilities, the officials do not share everything they know, most times because they say it would violate someone's privacy. There is truth to that, but without all the information, how can Texas expect parents to make an informed decision?
