The Texas Department of Transportation invites the public to participate in a virtual or in-person meeting for the proposed US 183 N widening project in Lampasas County. In-Person Public Meetings will be held at the following location: Thurs., July 14th 5:30pm – 7:30pm- Old Lampasas Middle School On Western Ave. between North Ave. and Ave. B. Lampasas, TX 76550

The purpose of the project is to improve the safety and mobility of US 183. The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional right of way in some locations. Construction timing is not yet known.

The limits of the proposed project will be from just south of Lometa at US 190 to just north of US 281 in the city of Lampasas.

### **ERCOT** and the **Power Grid**

For the second time this week, the state's power grid operator asked Texans to turn up their thermostats to 78 degrees and to avoid using large appliances as it expected record-high demand for power amid ongoing scorching temperatures. It was asking for conservation from 2 to 9 p.m. Wednesday.

A spokesperson for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas, the state's main power grid operator, said he did not expect rolling blackouts to happen Wednesday.

The call for conservation came because of higher-than-expected outages at coal and natural gas-fired power plants, as well as low winds, as demand continues to rise because (cont'd on back)



"The fleet has been run extremely hard this year and especially this summer, so it's not surprising that wear-and-tear is starting to bear out in the form of components breaking," said Michele Richmond, executive director of the Texas Competitive Power Advocates, which represents power generators.

.Solar power, which has performed well this summer, was also struggling Wednesday to produce as much electricity as expected, ERCOT said, because of some dark clouds over solar farms in West Texas.

When Texans were asked Monday to conserve electricity, ERCOT said that appeal reduced demand on the power grid by 500 megawatts during the afternoon. ERCOT did not come close to implementing rolling blackouts.

Power grids must keep supply and demand in balance at all times. When Texas' grid falls below its safety margin of excess supply, the grid operator starts taking additional precautions to avoid blackouts.

There has been no request at this time for conservation for today.

## Texas Democratic Party and Possible New Leadership

Texas Democratic Party chair Gilberto Hinojosa is facing two challengers for reelection at the party's convention this weekend, a race that is serving as a referendum on Democrats' pace of progress in a still-red state.

Hinojosa has held the job for a decade, but his opponents, Kim Olson and Carroll G. Robinson, argue it is a time for a change, especially after the disappointing 2020 election. Hinojosa says he has expanded the party immensely since he took over in 2012, placing it on the cusp of statewide victory in November. "The margins that we have gone from when I took over to where we're at now have got us in a trajectory of flipping the state within a very short period of time, including this election cycle," Hinojosa said.

But Hinojosa's critics say they are tired of moral victories and promises that a major breakthrough is near.

"We need to win, and losing and pretending to win doesn't help the people we say we represent as Democrats in the state," said Robinson, chair of the Texas Coalition of Black Democrats. Hinojosa's fate will be decided by the thousands of delegates gathering in Dallas for the biennial convention, which runs Thursday through Saturday. In addition to electing party leadership, delegates will also update their platform and hear speeches from dozens of elected officials, candidates and activists. The lineup includes national party chair Jaime Harrison and the statewide slate, led by gubernatorial contender Beto O'Rourke.
