District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on July 22nd. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 46 cases were brought to the court with 32 cases involving men, and 14 cases involving women. Tyler McMillian of Lampasas failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Jon Collins of Lampasas also failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

There were 21 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 12 cases for less than a gram, with one of those being in a drug free zone, and 8 cases for 1-4 grams. There was one case for manufacture/delivery/possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams. For possession of a controlled substance PG2, there was one case for less than a gram and one case for 1-4 grams. There were 4 DWI cases.

There were 4 burglary cases, two for evading arrest, one for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and one for theft of property.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 4 cases of assault on a family member, and one case each of aggravated assault of a public servant, intoxication assault, and abandoning or endangering a child. There were 2 cases of sexual assault of a child, one case for failing to comply as a sex offender and one case of indecency with a child/sexual contact.

Of the 25 cases 13 were resolved with Christopher Henderson pleading guilty and being sentenced to 5 years TDCJ with credit for days served plus court costs on each of 3 charges of DWI 3rd or more. Carly Yoho of Lampasas saw her charge of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle dismissed. Oceanbleau Bedell of Copperas Cove was sentenced to 5 years probation plus court costs and fines on one charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram, on the other charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram (cont'd on back)


