The Weather

The high yesterday 101° This morning's low 74°



Today: Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 101°. Winds will be S-SW near 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies and the low temperature will dip to near 75° with S winds near 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Thursday: Sunny and hot with a high temperature near 100°. Winds will be S-SW at 5-10 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 75°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Friday: Skies will be sunny with the temperature topping out near 100°. Wind will be S near 5-15 mph.

Friday Night: Partly cloudy skies and the low will be near 75°. Winds will be S near 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Just How Hot Is It?

It sure seems like it has been over 100° every day for weeks now. According to the Weather Service at the Lampasas Airport the 1st 100° day this year was May 7th when the temperature reached 102°, and it was the only 100° day in May of this year. In 2021 according to the Lampasas Airport data the 1st 100° day was September 5th that the temperature reached the century mark. It was also the only 100° day on record for last year.

There were 13 days in May with the temperature reaching the upper 90's this year, compared with no days in the upper 90's or 100° readings for Lampasas for 2021.

June this year brought 11 days of 100° heat with the hottest days being 104° on June 11th and 12th. The coolest high this year in June was 86° on June 2nd, and there were 14 days in the upper 90's. June of last year shows no 100° days for the month, 18 days in the lower 90's and no days in the upper 90's.

The month of July so far, shows 16 days when the temperature reached the 100° mark, with the hottest day being 105° on July 10th. The remainder of the days of July this year have been in the

upper 90's. The coolest high temperature for July of this year was 96° on July 1st and 15th. Last year in July the Lampasas airport showed no 100° readings with just 12 days in the upper 90's. For those counting, as of this morning there have been 28 days of 100° or hotter weather so far this year in Lampasas. The current streak of 100° days in Lampasas is at 0 days. (It was only 99° yesterday).

In nearby Gatesville, the first 100° day was on June 6th when the temperature reached 100°. Gatesville shows no 100° days in May of this year, 11 days at 100° or higher in June, and 20 days of 100° temperatures this July. The thermometer at Gatesville topped out at 106° pm the 10th, 13th, 18th, and 19th of July of this year. Last year Gatesville also had their first 100° day on September 5th and another on September 20th. Those were the only two 100° days recorded for Gatesville last year. Gatesville has recorded 31 days of 100° or over temperature readings so far this year. The 100° streak is 11 days for Gatesville.

Gatesville has received 4.34 inches of rain since May 1st. The Lampasas Airport has received 3.37 inches of rain since May 1st. In 2021 Lampasas received a total of 9.96 inches of rain in May June and July. In Gatesville for May, June and July of 2021 there was 8.47 inches of rain.

The Blotter



The Lampasas Police blotter for Wednesday shows a suspicious vehicle reported in the 100 block of E. 9th St. at 1am. The afternoon shows a reported theft in the 1500 block of S. Key Ave. at 1:09pm. There was a reported domestic disturbance in the 300 block of S. Arnold St. at 1:49 pm, and another domestic disturbance at the same location at 3pm. At 3:38pm, Douglas Faught, 82, of Lampasas was arrested in the 1100 block of Limestone Dr. on 4 Lampasas Police Dept. warrants (Two warrants for solicitation of prostitution of a person under 18 years of age, and two warrants for unlawful restraint of a person under 17 years of age). There was a reported theft in the 1100 block of E. Ave E at 9:27pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter shows Lometa with an accident (see story), and a warrant was served. In Kempner there was a report of criminal mischief, a reported harassment, and reports of suspicious activity. Out in the county there were medical calls, livestock issues, reports of suspicious activity, a request for extra patrol and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on reports of suspicious activity, civil matters, reported disturbances, and a fish & game call.

Fatality Accident on FM 580W

From the Texas Department of Public Safety: "Texas DPS Troopers responded to a one vehicle fatality crash. A 2022 Chevrolet pick-up truck, operated by 66-year-old Larry Carroll Derwacter, of Lometa, Texas, was travelling eastbound on FM 580 west of Lampasas. According to the investigating Trooper the Chevrolet failed to drive in single lane, left the roadway, and collided with a tree. Derwacter was not wearing a safety belt and died on scene. Derwacter was pronounced deceased by Justice of the Peace Camron Brister. Next of kin have been notified. For a complete copy of this crash report go to Texas.gov.

Rank One Paperwork

Attention all Middle School and High School athletes of ANY sport grades 7-12!!

Please go ahead and complete your athletic "paperwork" in Rank One. This link will take you to their website and give you instructions. You may use your same account from last year but these have to be filled out annually. The only PAPER form we need is the physical and medical history form. The medical history form is done every year and is the front side of the physical form. It can be printed off our athletic training link and handed into the athletic trainer or LMS coach. They will appear to you as "ineligible" until the athletic trainer has checked the medical history off in Rank One.

Your child can also receive a paper copy the first few days of school. Please remember that your child won't be allowed to participate in athletics until a current physical is on file.

Specific info about this is on the athletic training link as well. Rank One has an app. However, a desktop may be more user friendly for viewing and signing.
