## CDC Mask Guidelines

An article in the Texas Tribune shares that new evidence that the delta variant of the coronavirus could be spread through rare "breakthrough" infections in vaccinated people, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention on Tuesday recommended increased public mask use in regions where the variant is spreading quickly and at schools.

The new guidelines are aimed at everyone, regardless of whether they've been vaccinated, signaling a reversal by the CDC for the first time since recommendations were relaxed in May.

In Texas, however, Republican state leaders held their ground against allowing local schools and governments to require masks, sticking with statewide bans on pandemic-era restrictions even as hospitalizations continue to rise and large cities and counties in the state have been strengthening their health recommendations.

The CDC now recommends that all students, teachers and visitors wear masks in schools, and that vaccinated people start masking up again in indoor public spaces in "areas with substantial and high transmission," officials said Tuesday.

The CDC defines a substantial-transmission area as having 50-99 new infections for every 100,000 people over a seven-day period.

A high-transmission area is reporting 100 or more per 100,000 during that time frame. In Texas, out of 254 counties, more than 200 are considered substantial- or high-transmission areas, according to the CDC.

The new CDC guidelines are not mandates and don't carry the weight of law, and Texas is one of a handful of states that won't allow enforcement of such rules.

"Unlike the alpha variant that we had back in May, where we didn't believe that if you were vaccinated you could transmit the virus, this is different with delta," Dr. Rochelle Walensky, director of the CDC said. "We are seeing that it is now possible, with the rare breakthrough infection, that you can transmit it further, which is the reason for the change."

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the Texas Tribune, there were 10,086 new and 2811 probable new cases on 7/28/21, along with 59 deaths, and 5,292 in the hospital.

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 5 new confirmed cases yesterday with the 14 day total at 74 cases. The DSHS website estimates Lampasas at 100 active cases.

### Kempner/Copperas Cove

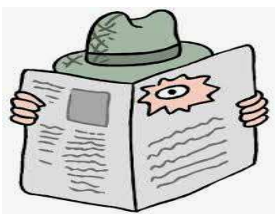

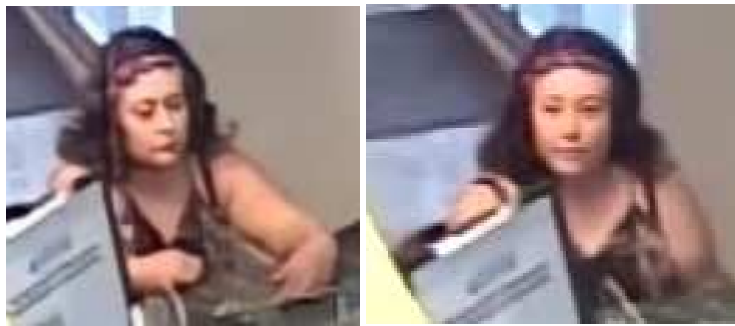
