The Weather



The High yesterday 99° The Low this morning 75°

Today: Mostly sunny skies with a high temperature near 100°. We will see S-SW wind at 5-10 mph this afternoon.

Tonight: Look for partly cloudy skies with a low near 75°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Saturday: The sky will be sunny, and the high temperature will be near 100°. Wind will be SW at 5-10 mph.

Saturday Night: Look for partly cloudy skies with a low temperature near 75°. The wind will be S near 10 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Sunday: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 101°. Winds will be S-SW near 5-10 mph.

Overnight Sunday: Mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 74°. Wind will be S at 5-10 mph gusting as high as 20 mph.

Dog Ridge Fire

Emergency crews continue to monitor progress on a Bell County fire that has burned hundreds of acres, (picture below right), but has not damaged any structures. The fire is south of I-14 and west of FM 1670..

The Dog Ridge Fire, as it is being called, is around 15% contained, according to the Texas A&M Forest Service. Ground crews indicate that 235 acres have burned

Smoke remains the biggest hazard and will continue to be going into Friday morning.

Beside lots of brush and trees, the fire also crept into a vehicle salvage yard. That is what caused such heavy, black plumes of smoke to arise throughout Thursday afternoon when the fire started. Some of what has been burned includes vehicles and tires.

Officials with the forest service said that is what contributed to the need to have air crews drop water and retardant onto the fire. So far, there has been no damage to any structure and no injuries have been reported. There are also no evacuation orders in effect. On Wednesday, Texas A&M Forest Service firefighters responded to 13 new wildfires that burned approximately 446 acres. Suppression efforts continued on several carryover wildfires as well.

The Chalk Mountain Fire is still at 6,746 acres and is now 67% contained as of 6:52pm yesterday.

High pressure is forecast to weaken slightly through the weekend and southerly winds may transport low level gulf moisture inland. The added moisture in the fire environment should result in low to moderate significant fire potential for the Eastern/Western Hill Country, Cross Timbers and eastern Rolling Plains. There is low significant fire potential for the rest of the state.

The Blotter

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept. for Thursday shows Kempner with a requested welfare check, a suicidal person, a reported trespassing, a reported stolen vehicle, reports of suspicious behavior and medical calls. Out in the county there were livestock issues, medical calls, civil matters, and juvenile problems. Deputies went into Cove on livestock issues.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 32 year old Joshua Jackson of Kempner for evading arrest/detention w/a vehicle.

From the Copperas Cove Police Dept.:

"On July 28, 2022, at approximately 7:51 A.M., Copperas Cove Police Officers responded to the 600 block of S 23rd Street for a report of shots fired. Officers arrived on scene, and witnesses reported a male subject entered a residence and exited a short time later. Before the subject departed, witnesses reported he fired three rounds into the residence with a pistol. There were no injuries as a result of the shooting.

Witnesses provided officers with a description of the suspect and reported he fled the scene in a white Nissan Titan. Officers obtained the suspect's identity and immediately broadcasted the information to surrounding agencies.

Deputies with Coryell and Lampasas County Sheriff's Offices assisted in locating the suspect outside the city limits. Copperas Cove Police Officers responded to their location, where the suspect was taken into custody and charged with Burglary of a Habitation with Intent to Commit Felony and Deadly Conduct/ Discharge Firearm. An update will be provided after the suspect has been arraigned.

Rank One Paperwork

Attention all Middle School and High School athletes of ANY sport grades 7-12!!

Please go ahead and complete your athletic "paperwork" in Rank One. This link will take you to their website and give you instructions. You may use your same account from last year but these have to be filled out annually. The only PAPER form we need is the physical and medical history form. The medical history form is done every year and is the front side of the physical form. It can be printed off our athletic training link and handed into the athletic trainer or LMS coach. They will appear to you as "ineligible" until the athletic trainer has checked the medical history off in Rank One.

Your child can also receive a paper copy the first few days of school. Please remember that your child won't be allowed to participate in athletics until a current physical is on file. Specific info about this is on the athletic training link as well. Rank One has an app. However, a desktop may be more user friendly for viewing and signing.
