The Weather

The heat index reached 99° yesterday

Today: Sunny skies with a high near 96°, and a possible heat index of 103°. Winds will be calm.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies with a low around 76° winds will be SE at 5-10 mph.

Sunday: Mostly sunny and up to 96° with a 40% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. The heat index could reach 106°. Winds will be S at 5 mph.

Sunday Night: Overnight it gets down to 74° with mostly cloudy skies, and calm winds. There is a 40% chance of precipitation.

Monday: Look for a high near 90°, and skies will be mostly cloudy. There is a 70% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. Wind will be light from the north.

DPS Graduates Largest Class

The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) commissioned 145 new Texas Highway Patrol Troopers from its A-2021 recruit class during a graduation ceremony on Friday, July 30. It's the largest recruit school graduation in DPS history and also one of the most diverse.

The ceremony was held at the Great Hills Baptist Church in Austin. This was the department's 167th recruit class, with recruits ranging in age from 21 to 50 years old. This year's class included 21 females graduating, the most in one recruit class.



Coronavirus Update



Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 13,149 new and 2,744 probable new cases on 7/30/21, along with 57 deaths. On July 30th, there were 5,846 Texans in the hospital with coronavirus.

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 6 new confirmed cases in Lampasas county, and 78 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The DSHS website estimates 110 actual cases in Lampasas County for yesterday.

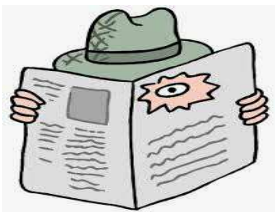

Road Work Reminder

Kempner/Copperas Cove

TxDOT Waco District has been doing scheduled maintenance and repairs to the US 190 Bypass, from FM 2657 to I-14. Work began Tuesday, July 20th, and is expected to wrap up around August 3rd. During this time, Big Creek Construction will continue pavement repairs along the US 190 Bypass. Work is expected to be completed during the daytime hours, and motorists should anticipate intermittent lane closures and delays throughout the day

Lampasas
Work will continue the following roadways in Lampasas County:
US 281: From Adamsville to 0.35 mile north of US 183
US 190: From the east side of the city of Lampasas (near Walmart) to the city of Kempner FM
580: From US 183 to 1.2 miles east of FM 1715 FM
580: From FM 2313 to the Coryell County line
Schedule of work is subject to change, weather permitting and other unforeseen delays.

Motorists should expect various lane closures and plan for possible delays in travel. A pilot car will guide traffic through these work zones. Motorists are asked to use caution, avoid distractions and slow their speed.

Sales Tax Holiday Coming Soon

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar is reminding shoppers they can save money on clothes and school supplies during the state's sales tax holiday Aug. 6-8, next weekend.

State law exempts sales tax on qualified items — such as clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks — priced below \$100, saving shoppers about \$8 on every \$100 they spend. The date of the sales tax holiday and list of tax-exempt items are set by the Texas Legislature.

"For many families with children who are going back to their school campuses for the first time since the pandemic began, the sales tax holiday is the perfect opportunity to save money on school supplies and other tax-free items," Hegar said. "As a father with three school-aged children myself, I know how these expenses can add up." Apparel and school supplies that may be purchased tax-free are listed on the Comptroller's website at TexasTaxHoliday.org.
