

The City of Lampasas has rescinded the boil water notice for residents. You no longer have to boil water. If you are experiencing milky water, please know that it is air in the line and it will subside.

Red Flag Warning





Lampasas County is expected to experience extreme fire danger this afternoon with temperatures expected to reach 104-110 degrees, south winds between 10 & 20 mph and a relative humidity of 17-24%. No outdoor burning of any kind is permitted during a red flag warning.

So far this year we have reached triple digits 32 times. The total rainfall to date for 2023 in Lampasas has been 7.75 inches with the last measurable precipitation being on July 2nd when the airport received .08 inches of rain. In 2022 Lampasas had 37 100° days. In 2011 Lampasas reached 100° on 61 days.

From Texas A & M Forestry Service

From the Texas A & M Forestry Service:

Over the weekend, the Texas A&M Forestry Service responded to 18 new requests for assistance on wildfires that burned 940.3 acres across the state.

On Wednesday, there is a high potential for large wildfires due to critical fire weather forecast for areas along and west of I-35 and into Central and East Texas where critically to extremely dry fuel is present. Wildfires will likely exhibit high resistance to control in high-risk areas where there is a lot of Juniper for fuel.

When combined with increased fire weather, dry to extremely dry fuel will support high levels of wildfire activity across much of the state this week. There is also potential for large wildfires to occur Tuesday through Thursday with high temperatures over 100° , strong south winds and extremely low humidity.

As of Sunday at 10:25am the Classic Canyon fire in Coryell County was 235 acres and 85% contained.

1st August Supermoon Tonight

The 1st full supermoon of this month will be tonight, and is the 2nd of 4 supermoons in a row this year according to *earthsky.org*. The 1st supermoon was on July 2nd, tonight is the 2nd, August 30th will be the 3rd and September 28th will be the 4th. A supermoon is a new or full moon which occurs with the moon at or near (within 90% of) its closest approach to Earth in a given orbit.

Look for the bright, round moon in the east shortly after sunset today, it is highest in the sky around midnight and low in the west before sunrise tomorrow.

The supermoon on August 30th will be the closest full moon, and, therefore, the largest supermoon of the year. So not only does it appear to be the biggest full moon of the year, but it also appears to be the brightest, it's also a monthly Blue Moon.

In astronomy, a blue moon is the second full moon in a calendar month. The next monthly Blue Moon is not until May 31st, 2026. And the next time we'll have a closer full supermoon is November 5, 2025, when the moon lies 221,817 miles from Earth.

Extreme Heat Causing Gasoline Prices to Rise

According to a story by Scripps News, multiple days of temperatures exceeding 100 degrees in the Southern states are affecting oil refineries in Texas and Louisiana, diminishing gas supplies and increasing prices.

Nationally, gas prices are up 13 cents compared with a week ago, according to the price-tracking website GasBuddy.

"Refineries are outdoors and exposed to the elements," GasBuddy head of petroleum analysis Patrick De Haan told Spectrum News. "A lot of the equipment at refineries is designed for normal temperatures, not extremes."

Four of the nation's largest refineries are in Texas, including Port Arthur, Galveston, Baytown and Beaumont along the Gulf Coast. Temperatures in that area have been hovering around 100° for more than a week with no end in sight.

Another three are in Louisiana, including Garyville, Baton Rouge and Lake Charles. The extreme heat wave in that area is among the worst on record. About half of the nation's refining capacity is in Louisiana and Texas, supplying gas to every part of the country except California and Colorado. Six of the refineries in those states are experiencing heat-related outages, De Haan said. Heat-related power outages, storms and lightning strikes are among several causes that have led to refinery outages this summer. The problems are likely to persist for a couple more weeks, keeping gas prices high.

Oil prices are also adding pressure to gas prices. They are now at their highest level since April. In June, the U.S. Energy Information Administration predicted lower-than-previously expected global oil production because of OPEC announcing it will continue to cut crude oil production through 2024. In July, Saudi Arabia announced an additional oil production cut of one million barrels per day.

"With OPEC muddying the waters by cutting production, prices may remain elevated going into the fall," De Haan said. "We may see a little break once we get beyond the
