The Weather

High yesterday was 96°

The low this morning was 71°

Today: Mostly sunny with a high near 98°. W-SW wind at 5-10 mph becoming E-SE in the afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low near 76°. Winds will be E-SE 5-10 mph shifting to the south after midnight.

Saturday: Partly sunny with a high near 94°, and heat indexes as high as 98°, S-SW wind 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers after 1pm.

Saturday night: a 40% chance of showers and storms with mostly cloudy skies and a low near 74°

Sunday: A high near 92° and partly sunny skies with a 20% chance of showers. S wind at 5 mph becoming N-NW in the afternoon.

Temperatures Sunday should be cooler across the region due to increased cloudiness and a weak cold front. Monday sees the ridge moving east and the cool front lifting back to the north resulting in higher temperatures.

Next Week Looks like summer with highs in the upper 90's and lows in the mid 70's. Storm chances next week will be low due to the ridge of high pressure overhead.

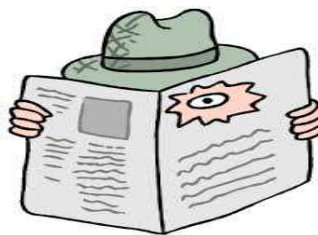
