Another Red Flag Day


The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for Lampasas County beginning at 1pm today and continuing through 1am tomorrow morning. Lampasas County is expected to experience critical fire danger this afternoon with temperatures expected to reach 103-110 degrees, south winds of 10-15 mph and a relative humidity of 18-23%. Rapid ignition and spread of wild-fires is possible due to persistent hot and dry conditions. No outdoor burning of any kind is permitted during a red flag warning.

Yesterday was the 34th day of 2023 with temperatures in the triple digits and the 5^{th} consecutive day, (We did not reach 100° on Friday), 2022 saw 37 days total in the triple digits and 2011 had 61 days at 100° or above. Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 605.95 feet elevation this morning.


