## A couple of Back to School things....

### Tax Free Weekend

(AUSTIN) — Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar is reminding shoppers they can save money on clothes and school supplies during the state's sales tax holiday on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, Aug. 5-7.

State law exempts sales tax on qualified items — such as clothing, footwear, school supplies and backpacks — priced below \$100, saving shoppers about \$8 on every \$100 they spend. The dates of the sales tax holiday and list of tax-exempt items are set by the Texas Legislature.

"Most Texans won't hear the back-to-school bell for another

month, but it's never too early to take advantage of the opportunity to save money on everything from book bags to ballpoint pens," Hegar said. "With inflation driving prices higher on just about everything, this sales tax holiday provides Texas families some small relief managing the costs associated with kids heading back to the classroom. As the father of three school-aged children myself, I know how these expenses can add up." The Comptroller's office estimates that shoppers will save \$112 million in state and local sales tax during this sales tax holiday. Apparel and school supplies that may be purchased tax-free are listed on the Comptroller's website at [TexasTaxHoliday.org](http://TexasTaxHoliday.org). During the annual sales tax holiday, qualifying items can be purchased tax free online or by telephone, mail, custom order or any other means (including in-store purchases) when either: 1) the item is both delivered to, and paid for by, the customer during the exemption period; or, 2) the customer orders and pays for the item, and the seller accepts the order during the exemption period for immediate shipment, even if delivery is made after the exemption period ends.

Texas' sales tax holiday weekend has been an annual event since 1999.

### From TxDot Pedestrian Safety

As millions of Texas children head back to school, the Texas Department of Transportation is reminding drivers to stay focused and drive safe in and around school zones and bus stops. This includes adhering to a new Texas law that requires drivers to stop and yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.

Everyone has a responsibility to keep children safe on their way to and from school. TxDOT offers these safety tips for drivers, parents and students:

Tips for Driving in School Zones:

\* Be aware that traffic patterns around schools may have changed since the last school year.

\* Always obey school zone speed limit signs. Remember, traffic fines increase in school zones.

\* Drop off and pick up your children in your school's designated areas, not the middle of the street.

\* Keep an eye on children gathered at bus stops.

\* Watch for children who might dart across the street or between vehicles.

### **Tips for Drivers Sharing the Road with School Buses**

\* Follow at a safe distance, keeping in mind that school buses make frequent stops.

\* Always remain alert for children around buses and remember that they may not always look for vehicles before crossing the street.

\* Stop for flashing red lights or a stop sign on a school bus, regardless of which direction you're headed. Continue your trip once the bus has moved, the flashing lights stop flashing or the bus driver signals it's okay to pass.

\* Violations can lead to a fine of up to \$1,250 for a first offense.
