**Today:** Mostly sunny skies and a high temperature near 89° with a 30% chance of showers and storms later this afternoon. Wind will be S-SE at 5-10 mph

**Tonight:** Look for mostly clear skies with a low temperature near 71°. Wind will be S-SE at 5-10 mph.

## Vaccine Update

Lampasas Radio reported last week that the Moderna Vaccine is available at the Family Medicine Center in Lampasas free of charge.

This is the case, however we found out yesterday that there is a waiting list. This is what we were told; Patients call to get on the vaccine list, and when the doses are received, that many patients are called in to get the vaccine that week. The vaccine clinic is every Friday, and normally 30-50 vaccines are given out. If you want the vaccine through the Family Medical Clinic, you should call to get on the vaccine list, then when the doses arrive people are contacted with a time and date to go to the clinic to receive the vaccination. You do not have to be an FMC patient to receive the free vaccination.

## Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, statewide there were 15,558 new and 3,445 probable new cases on August 4th, along with 60 deaths, and 7,685 in the hospital.

Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 11 new confirmed cases yesterday with the 14 day total at 133 cases. The DSHS website estimates Lampasas at 163 active cases.

## CDC Extends Eviction Moratorium

CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky Tuesday signed an order determining the evictions of tenants for failure to make rent or housing payments could be detrimental to public health control measures to slow the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. This order will expire on October 3, 2021 and applies in United States counties experiencing substantial and high levels of community transmission levels of SARS-CoV-2.

The eviction moratorium allows additional time for rent relief to reach renters and to further increase vaccination rates. In the context of a pandemic, eviction moratoria—like quarantine, isolation, and social distancing—can be an effective public health measure utilized to prevent the spread of communicable disease. Eviction moratoria facilitate self-isolation and self-quarantine by people who become ill or who are at risk of transmitting COVID-19 by keeping people out of congregate settings and in their own homes.

The below can be attributed to CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky: "The emergence of the delta variant has led to a rapid acceleration of community transmission in the United States, putting more Americans at increased risk, especially if they are unvaccinated. This moratorium is the right thing to do to keep people in their homes and out of congregate settings where COVID-19 spreads. It is imperative that public health authorities act quickly to mitigate such an increase of evictions, which could increase the likelihood of new spikes in SARS-CoV-2 transmission. Such mass evictions and the attendant public health consequences would be very difficult to reverse."

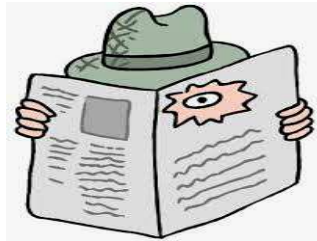
