Wednesday Night: Look for mostly clear skies with a low near 78° and S wind at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Thursday: Sunny skies and the high will be near 106° with S wind near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear skies with a low near 78° and S wind near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

Local Wildfires

The Lucy Creek Fire, on CR 3420 jumped the containment line at about 4:30 yesterday afternoon. Crews responded from Lampasas and the surrounding areas along with the Texas Forestry Service. According to the Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department (Lampasas VFD), the Lucy Creek Fire is at 60% containment and there will be Texas Forestry Service crews at that site today. The Lampasas VFD also shared this morning that the Kirby Creek Fire, in Lometa, estimated by the forestry service at 78 acres is at 100% containment this morning.

Lampasas VFD also shared that they are getting low on water and Gatorade and are welcoming donations. You can drop off donations at the Lampasas Fire Station at 1107 E. 4th St. in Lampasas.

Red Flag Warning Today

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for



Lampasas County from 12-8pm today. Lampasas County is expected to experience critical fire danger this afternoon with temperatures expected to reach 103-108 degrees, south winds between 10 & 20 mph and a relative humidity of 20%. No outdoor burning of any kind is permitted during a red flag warning.

On Sunday, Texas A&M Forest Service responded to 17 new requests for assistance on wildfires that burned 1256 acres across the state.

Yesterday was the $39^{\text{th}} 100^{\circ}$ + day for Lampasas this year and the 10^{th} day in a row. Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 605.62 feet elevation this morning.

Preparedness Level 4

The Texas A&M Forest Service on August 7 raised the State Preparedness Level to Level 4 (PL 4) due to a significant increase in fire activity across the state and the "potential for large fires."

Level 4 means an increased commitment of state and local resources to combat fires.

Over the past seven days, the Texas A&M Forest Service has responded to 80 wildfires that burned 8,521 acres of land.

Forty-one of these wildfires occurred since Friday, August 4.

"Wildfire activity has continued to increase statewide as triple digit temperatures and dry conditions continue to impact the state," the agency said.
