

Meetings Today

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court will meet this

morning at 9am in the Commissioners courtroom at the Lampasas County Courthouse. The Agenda includes; approval of the consent agenda, review of the 2022 Sheriff's and Constable's fees, a presentation on the preservation of the night skies, a request for the creation of a 911 Emergency



The Lampasas City Council will begin with a special/executive session at 5:30 today. The Executive session is to discuss settlement of threatened litigation related to possible breach of contract for use of public right of way and attachment to city utility poles and other matters. The council will return to regular session to take action on any items from the executive session.

The Workshop session will include a COVID update, discussion regarding the Lampasas County Chamber of Commerce, and discussion of the 2021/2022 budget.

The Regular session will then convene and include citizen comments, the consent agenda, boards and departmental reports, and routine matters to include the City Manager's report. New Business will include discussion and possible action on some HOT funding for the Chamber of Commerce, creating a 911 emergency district, a specific use permit for 607 W. 1st St. to allow for an accessory dwelling, the Hidden Oaks final plat, and approval of the investment and strategy policy resolution.

The Lampasas ISD School Board will meet this evening at 6pm at the LISD administration building. The agenda will include the consent agenda, the Lampasas Central Appraisal District Budget, approving a date for the public hearing on the budget and proposed tax rate for 2021/2022, administrative reports, and consultation with Attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 5,377 new and 363 probable new cases on 8/08/21, along with 28 deaths. There were also 9,027 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the

DSHS dashboard for cases shows -28 new confirmed cases in Lampasas county on August 7th, and 147 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas county to have 201 active cases at this time.

Covid Vaccine Waste

(KXAN) As hospitalizations statewide have increased in recent weeks, so has the demand for the COVID-19 vaccine. Still, thousands of doses have been wasted in the last few months, according to state data.

More than 420,000 doses have been spoiled, expired or lost since the state began receiving shipments of the vaccine in December, according to data from Texas Department of State Health Services. The majority of those wasted doses were reported since May. From December through April, the state allocated providers doses on a weekly basis. In early May, the state shifted from the allocation model to a model based on orders from providers, as-needed. Those doses were then shipped to the providers from the DSHS Pharmacy or from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention on a daily basis. Before this change, DSHS also published a weekly report of wasted doses, but the agency stopped posting those numbers publicly online when the distribution model shifted.

KXAN investigators obtained DSHS data which shows 402,025 doses were reported as wasted, just since the beginning of May. Prior to that, 21,088 doses had been reported as wasted.

A spokesperson for the state acknowledged the spike and pointed to a drop off in demand from the public around the same time. In early May, the agency began directing providers to vaccinate anyone who wanted a vaccine — even if it meant opening a new vial and wasting the rest of the doses it contained.
