The Weather

The High yesterday 97° The Low this morning 76°



The Heat Index in Lampasas reached 99° yesterday. The main weather story is the heat. Hot and humid with heat indices reaching 104°-108°. However, in our area humidity values will be low enough that we have to keep an eye on fire danger.

Today: Look for sunny skies and a high near 101°, with a possible heat index of 104°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. .

Tonight: Skies will be mostly clear with a low temperature near 76°. Winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Tuesday: Sunny skies and a high near 101°. Winds will be light from the south.

Tuesday Night: Look for clear skies overnight, with a low temperature near 75°. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny and hot with a high near 102°. Wind will be S-SW wind at 5-10 mph, gusting to 20 mph.

Wednesday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 76°, and S winds at 5-10.

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Georgia Hay shared with the Radiogram that Lampasas County has had its 5th fatality from COVID-19. Now has over 200 cases total. The active cases are in the 30's. There is one Lampasas County Resident in the hospital at this time. Texas reported 4,879 new cases yesterday. There are 7,437 Texans in the hospital with COVID-19.



Commissioners' Notes

This morning, the Lampasas County Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting live at 9am via Zoom to go over a list of agenda items.

During the meeting, the consent agenda for a previously called meeting that took place on July 27th 2020 was approved. Accounts payable and payroll were discussed, with two new approved additions; Atmos Energy and AT&T.

A preliminary plat for River Hill Ranches was approved, as well as a final plat for Shooting Star Ranch.

No action was taken on a revision to the Final Subdivision plat for Lampasas River Place II at this time.

As for the 2021 sheriffs and constable fees, the Lampasas county office will not change the fees for this year.

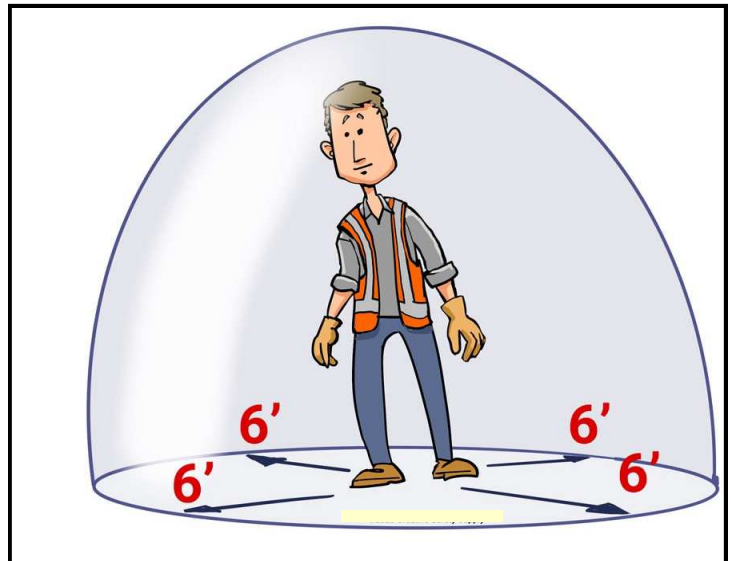
An update of the county road inventory was approved to be submitted to the Texas Department of Transportation for 2019 at 449 miles.

A rescind on the burn ban for Lampasas County was approved and a new ban was accepted. The new ban restricts outdoor burning, with exceptions such as outside BBQ, above ground grills, burning of household trash, and controlled burns by a prescribed burn. Additionally, all fireworks are illegal except firework shows by professionals. This burn ban will take place through November 8th 2020.

No action will be taken on a change order for a cable tray at the Lampasas jail until more information is provided.

England Engineering was selected for the engineering services position for subdivisions and/or other Lampasas county projects. They were selected out of three different proposals. Judge Randy Hoyer will now be working on a fee schedule and contract details with England Engineering. This is not a full time position, it is a contracted service.

As for the Jail Project 2017, the Commissioners' discussed an unusually high electric bill. The cost of the electricity bill is higher than that of smaller active jails. The matter is being looked into.

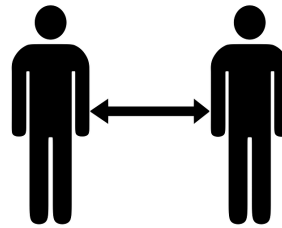

The City of Lampasas will hold a special session beginning at 5:30pm today, then adjourn into executive session to meet with an attorney concerning city matters. The will then return to special session to discuss/act on items discussed in executive session.

A workshop session for the city council will then begin immediately following the special session, which includes discussion/updates on the fiscal year 2020/2021 budget, and a COVID-19 update.

The regular session agenda includes a public hearing on the proposed budget, routine matters, the City Manager's report, and Mayor's comments. Under new business the council will discuss the Hillside Acres Preliminary Plat approval, an approval by resolution to apply for EDA

Grant Funding by Lampasas Economic Development Corp., a proposal for Hendrix consulting engineers for a limited assessment of maintenance/repair on the Hostess House, the 2020-2021 budget, the proposed tax rate upon all property subject to taxation in the city limits, scheduling a public hearing, the accelerated purchase of 18 V-300 body cameras, and a new telephone system for the Lampasas Police Dept.

Ft. Hood Training



According to an article in the **Killeen Daily Herald**, "A Fort Hood brigade is scheduled to bring in some Air Force firepower — in the form of B-52 bombers — for a live-fire exercise.

The strategic long range bombers will take part in a joint live-fire exercise known as Pegasus Forge on Tuesday in Fort Hood's training area, Fort Hood officials said. The 1st Cavalry Division's 1st Armored Brigade Combat Team is organizing the training that will test the brigade's "maneuver capabilities" and "exercise the ability of the unit to conduct large scale ground combat operations," according to the division. Units from the brigade are already out in the field and will conduct Exercise Pegasus Forge starting Sunday.

"The Combined Arms Live Fire Exercise will culminate at 5 p.m. on (Tuesday) with artillery, rocket, and Air Force assets participating," according to the division.
