Red Flag Warning in Effect! NO OUTDOOR BURNING!

Accident on 183 Tuesday

On Tuesday at about 5:38pm, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) troopers responded to a fatal crash on US 183 in Burnet County.

Preliminary investigation indicates that a 2017 Chevrolet 1500 pickup was traveling north on US 183 near milepost 458. A 2019 Mitsubishi Mirage and a 2019 Subaru Tribeca were traveling south on US 183. The driver of the Chevrolet crossed the center stripe divider and struck the Mitsubishi. After coming to rest in the south bound inside lane, the Mitsubishi was struck by the Subaru. As a result of the crash, the driver of the Mitsubishi was pronounced deceased on scene. The driver of Chevrolet sustained minor injuries. The driver of Subaru sustained injuries and was flown to a medical facility for treatment.


