The Weather



The high yesterday 98° This morning's low 75°

Today: Mostly sunny and up to 98° with heat index values up to 101. The light south wind will generally be up in the 10-15 mph area and gusting to 20.

Tonight: Mostly clear, with a low around 76° and South wind 5-15 mph and gusting to 20.

Wednesday: Sunny and hot, with a high near 100° and wind shifting to S-SW and laying a bit to 5-10 mph.

Overnight, the temperature will drop to around 75° and the wind will shift around to S-SE at 5-10 mph.

The Rest of the Week: Thursday will bring a high of probably 101°, the same on Friday.

Saturday will start the weekend with 100° as a high and that will likely be a degree cooler on Sunday.

The wind will continue out of the south at 5-10 mph for the next several days. There could be a weather change, even a rain chance, by Monday.

District Court Aug. 7th



In District Court in Lampasas, presided over by Judge John Gauntt, some 15 individuals were brought before the bench.

Finished cases included a Thomas Carter Simmons of Lometa, charged with possession of a controlled substance, over a gram. A guilty plea brought a \$1,000 fine and \$325 in court costs.

Joshua Dickinson of Lampasas pled guilty to cruelty to a non-livestock animal and received a 3 yr deferred probation, along with a \$2,000 fine and court cost. An additional count of killing an animal was struck with the plea.

Felix Arroyo-Figueroa of Killeen, charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon pled guilty to assault causing bodily injury. He received a 1 year probated jail sentence and a fine of \$2,000 and \$305 court costs.

Dessa Yvonne Faubion of Lampasas was charged on a debit card abuse case, pled guilty, and must pay \$300 in fine and \$325 in court costs.

Other cases were resets, pre-trial sets and arraignments.

City Council Meeting

The Lampasas city council held their regularly scheduled meeting live last night via YouTube and in person to go over and discuss a list of agenda items. During their regular session the consent agenda was approved as presented. No comments were made during public comments.



City manager Finley Digrafnay was present at the meeting to give his operational report.

We were approved for a Texas historical marker for the Cowvart municipal building. Finley stated that "The libraries park is really coming along" and that the city has received many positive comments on the work there, as well as the library. As for Lafta, they held a meeting and discussed the possibility of adding a skate park at Camble Park. There will be more discussion on this and the placement of a skate park in the future.

They have placed a temporary safety fence at Hanna Springs while they look into different safety options.

CDBG will be coming in to look at the roads for more work on Avenue C. They will be replacing a sewer line down from Key to Porter St.

During Mayor's comments, Mayor Misty wanted to thank her staff for all their hard work.

An additional six months time was added to the plate for Hillside Acers.

City council members accepted an approval to apply for an EDA Grant funding by the Lampasas economic development cooperation for the business park.

A proposal in the amount of \$2,500 for a mechanical, electrical, and plumbing assessment for the hostess house was approved.

A discussion and action was taken on the proposed tax rate on all property that is subject to taxation inside the city limits for the fiscal year from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2020. What they have currently budgeted this year is the same tax rate they've had since 2008.

On Tuesday September 8th, 2020 at 5pm, a public hearing will be held regarding the new proposed tax rate. Voting will take place on Monday September 16, 2020 at 6 pm.



An update for voting dates is to begin on October 13th, 2020 and continue through October 30th, 2020 for the post pond general election for the expired terms of council members. Three, four, and five was approved.

The investment and strategy policy resolution was approved. Members approved a payment plan for a total of \$3,650.15 for 18 body cameras from WatchGuard for the patrol division and animal control was accepted to not exceed 14,000.

An accelerated purchase of a new telephone system for the Lampasas police department from Southern Star Communications was approved, as long as cost did not exceed \$19,000. The phone system will connect to 39 phones.

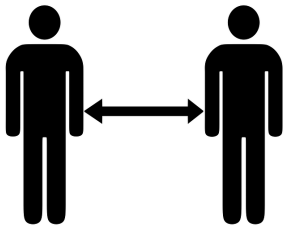

A county-wide burn ban with exceptions has been issued.

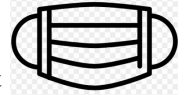
