The Blotter



The Lampasas Police blotter for Wednesday shows a report of a suspicious vehicle in the 1400 block of S. Key Ave. at 1:48am. There was a minor accident in the 900 block of E. 4th St. at 9:30am and a disturbance was reported in the 1700 block of CTE at 11:10am. The afternoon shows a minor accident in the 800 block of N. Key Ave. at 12:01pm, and another minor accident in the 400 block of S. Pecan St. at 12:11pm. At 12:50pm, Kolby Beaver, 30, of Lampasas was arrested in the 1500 block of S. Key Ave. on a Williamson County Warrant for assault causing bodily injury/family violence. There was suspicious activity reported in the 100 block of N. Summer St. at 2:50pm, and a minor accident at the intersection of Samac Ln. & W. 6th St. at 3:21pm. There was a suspicious person reported in the 600 block of N. Broad St. at 5:20pm and a disorderly conduct report in the 1700 block of CTE at 9:21pm. At 10:14pm, Richard Trevino, 37, of Lampasas was arrested in the 100 block of EE Ohnmeiss Dr. on 2 Lampasas Municipal Court Warrants (Ran red light/failure to maintain financial responsibility). A suspicious person was reported in the 500 block of S. Key Ave. at 10:52pm.

The Lampasas County Sheriff's Blotter shows Lometa with a request for extra patrol. In Kempner there were reports of suspicious activity, an alarm call, animal issues, a requested welfare check, a medical call and a grass fire. Out in the county there were reported trespassing, reports of suspicious activity, accidents, civil matters, a reported disturbance, and livestock issues. Deputies went into Cove for a suicidal person call.

The Jail Log shows the arrest of 51 year old Chance Pond of Hamilton on an out-of county charge. Also arrested was 29 year old Amanada Satterfield of Lampasas on 2 charges of assault causing bodily injury of a family member, and Billiy Joe Turner III, 23, of Carlton, Texas for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

(cont'd from front) the shift supervisor, the fire chief, and several police officers responded to the call. The first arriving firefighters found smoke emitting from an upstairs portion of the home, and were told that two residents were still inside the upstairs portion of the home. Mutual Aid assistance was immediately requested from Fort Hood Fire Department for a Fire Engine and Fort Hood EMS for one ambulance.

One resident was assisted out of an upstairs window by a neighbor and law enforcement personnel near the time that fire department units were arriving at the scene. Upon entry,

responding firefighters initiated a search for the other resident while simultaneous work was performed to extinguish the fire. The upstairs was heavily charged with smoke which caused a complete loss of visibility. The other resident was eventually found after a lengthy search and was immediately removed from the residence and moved instantly to an awaiting ambulance. The resident was found without any signs of life. The resident was transported to AdventHealth Hospital in Killeen where he was later deemed to have not survived.

The fire was declared under control approximately 30 minutes after arrival. The resident that exited via the window and a firefighter were also transported to AdventHealth later for evaluation. The residence sustained heavy flame and smoke damage to the entire upstairs portion of the home. Three persons and three pets have been displaced due to the fire

The cause of the fire is still under investigation by the Fire Marshal's office.

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced last week he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.2 Billion dollars in local sales tax allocations for August . These allocations are based on sales made in June by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate check increase by .89% over the same period last year, with a \$5751.28 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a 15.96% increase over the same period last year in their rebate check of \$91,699.50.

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is up 10.97% in their check of \$263,537.84. Lometa shows an increase of 37.29% with a rebate check for \$12,225.94. Kempner received a rebate for \$12,992.48, a 6.03% increase from last year.
