## **Sales Tax Rebates**

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced Wednesday he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.2 Billion dollars in local sales tax allocations for May. That is up 2.8% from last year. These allocations are based on sales made in June by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate increase by 23.57% over the same period last year, with a \$7107.25 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a 6.96% decrease over the same month last year in their rebate check of \$85,309.20

In Lampasas County, Lampasas shows their rebate is down a bit with a 2.13% decrease in their check of \$257,915.09. Lometa shows an increase of 13% from last year with a rebate check for \$13,815.84 and Kempner received a rebate for \$16,438.06, a 26.51% increase from last year.
