Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced Wednesday he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 1.07 billion in local sales tax allocations for August, 17.4 percent more than in August 2020. These allocations are based on sales made in June by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate check increase by 11.73% over the same period last year, with a \$5700.01 rebate. In Hamilton County, Hamilton saw an 11.78% increase over the same period last year in their rebate check of \$79,074.59.

In Lampasas County, Lampasas showed there was a 16.59% increase in their rebate of \$237,474.51. Lometa shows an increase of 13.64% with a rebate check for \$8905.00. Kempner received a rebate for \$12,252.67, a 7.72% increase for the same time frame.




