Today: Skies will be sunny with a high temperature near 106°. Winds will be from the S-SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.


Tonight: Look for clear skies with a low near 77°. Wind will be from the S near 15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Another Red Flag Warning Today

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for Lampasas County until 10pm Sunday. Lampasas County is expected to experience critical fire danger this afternoon with temperatures expected to reach 104-112 degrees, south winds gusting to 30 mph, and a relative humidity of 15%. No outdoor burning of any kind is permitted during a red flag warning.

Yesterday marked the 43rd day of 100° plus days this year, and 14 days of consecutive temperatures in the triple digits. Stillhouse Hollow Lake is at 605.38 feet elevation this morning. Lampasas has not had measurable rain since July 2nd.

Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will meet Monday August 14th at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda to include quarterly and monthly reports. The Agenda also includes accounts payable and payroll, new fee requirements on jury service, a petition for a local election filed on July 14th, presentation of the 2022 audit, discussion and a vote on the proposed tax rate for 2023 and setting a public hearing on the budget and tax rate, 2024 Sheriff's and Constable fees, accepting the resignation of the Precinct 2 & 3 Constable, Misty Maldonado, the Kempner Water stage IV water restrictions, and the Commissioner's Court Election Judges and Alternate Judges appointments.
